Biodiversity explains the varieties of species, genes in a certain ecosystem

- Ecology is not synonymous with environment, natural history, or environmental science.
- It is related to evolutionary biology, genetics, and ethology.

Ecologists explain

- Life processes,
- Interactions
- adaptations
- The movement of materials and energy
- The successional development
- The abundance and distribution of organisms
- biodiversity

The word "ecology" ("Ökologie") was firstly used in 1866 by the German scientist Ernst Haeckel (1834–1919).

Food Web

A food web is the ecological network.
Plants capture solar energy and use it to synthesize simple sugars during photosynthesis.

Food Chain

The simplified linear feeding pathways that move from a basal trophic species to a top consumer.
