Energy derived from terrestrial plants enters the water in the form of plant parts, such as leaves or twigs, or in the form of dissolved organic matter.

## The organic material used as a source of energy by microorganisms such as fungi and bacteria, and by invertebrates in aquatic environments.

In rivers (spring part) the external food source is more important



## **Cascade interactions**

It occurs in food webs when one group of organisms *indirectly* affects another group, by feeding on animals that eat the other group.  Changes to the structure of a food web by introducing or removing species, can have unpredictable results.
