Chalcedony; H. 36 mm., Diam. 16 mm.

Bearded hero wearing a kilt dominates two rampant sphinxes with feathered crowns by holding their forelegs (right sphinx unfinished). Small adorsed caprids flank the central figure.

Mesopotamia; Neo-Babylonian modeled style, 8th–7th century B.C.
Chalcedony; H. 33 mm., Diam. 15 mm.

Scorpionman and bullman brandishing weapons pull the hair of a kneeling male with six curls; an attendant figure in a fish robe with a bucket and a date spathe. In the field, a stylus, a bird, a fish, and a caprid.

bird-headed quadruped, a crescent, and a plant.

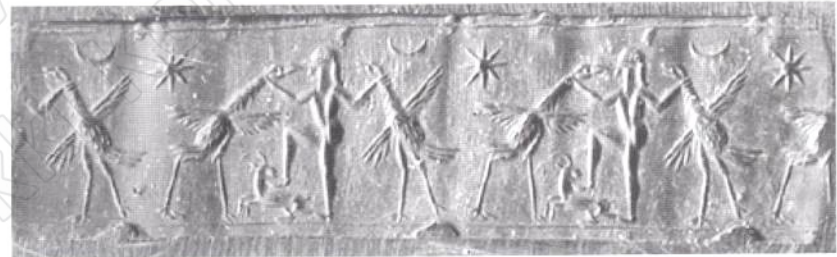
