Khan, Iftikhar Alam (2002) wrote a book in Urdu entitled, “Muslim University Ki Kahani (Imartor Ki Zabani from 1920 to 1947)” [History of Muslim University through buildings from 1920 to 1947)].⁵² In this book, author has given very important information about buildings of the Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh constructed during the period from 1920 to 1947.

Muhammad, Shan (2002) wrote a book entitled, “Education and Politics from Sir Syed to the Present Day (The Aligarh School)”⁵³ In this book the author covered the socio-political history of the Aligarh School from its inception to the date of writing this book.

In this book, the author discussed about the rise and fall of many movements and renowned personalities, their omissions and corrections, their secular and communal approaches and the incidents of division of the country.

The author gave details about the foundation of the Mohammadan Anglo Oriental College, Aligarh and also highlighted the Nationalist Trends at Aligarh from 1901 to 1937 and separatists Trends at Aligarh from 1938 to 1947. He also wrote in detail about the Aligarh Muslim University and its minority character.

Lelyveld, David (2003) wrote a book entitled, “Aligarh’s First Generation”.⁵⁴ For the first time it was published in 1978 by Princeton University Press and in India it was published for the first time in 1996 by arrangement with the original publisher, Oxford India Paperbacks 1996. The present book is the edition of 2003.
