2 DI and Pharmacist

- Pharmacist
- To ensure the patient receives the required information for the quality use of medications

- Help patients manage their chronic conditions / illnesses

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- Provide convenience of collecting and accessing information from a device that can be carried in a user's pocket.
- Convenient for providing medication profiles, setting up appointments, and searching DI databases.
