- Pharmacist
- To ensure the patient receives the required information for the quality use of medications



DI and Pharmacist

- Consult patients,
- Answer DI questions,
- Review patient medication regimens for possible problems and
- Help patients manage their chronic conditions / illnesses



ADE and Pharmacist

 - (2) the growing elderly population
 - (3) increased use of medications for disease prevention

- Provide convenience of collecting and accessing information from a device that can be carried in a user's pocket.
- Convenient for providing medication profiles, setting up appointments, and searching DI databases.
