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Course Description and Learning Goals: This course if for first-year students and consists of representative drama texts ranging from Greek tragedy to realistic plays. As this is an introductory course aiming at a literary appreciation of drama, we will discuss specific terms and elements relating to the study of drama in the light of a number of plays that illustrate various kinds of dramatic structure. We will analyze different forms of drama, and explore the selected plays in their various historical, cultural and social contexts.

Assessment: I ask that you complete every reading assignment, attend classes, regularly participate in discussions, and show respect for your peers. I will grade all work on a 0-100 scale and determine your final grade accordingly:

Mid-Term Exam (April 5 - April 22) 30%

Final Exam (May 31 -20 June) 80%
