Risk factors

- *Some examples:*
 - Structural abnormalities
 - Neurological disorders
 - Vesicoureteral reflux
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Microbiology

- *Escherichia coli* (> 85%) is the most common cause





Uncomplicated Cases

- *First choices:*
- Co-trimoxazole
- Nitrofurantoin





Other Alternatives

- Fosfomycin
 - Fluoroquinolones
 - Beta-lactams
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Recurrence

- Low dose
 - *Some examples:*
 - Co-trimoxazole
 - Nitrofurantoin
 - Trimethoprim

Prevention

- *Some examples:*
- Drinking plenty of water
- Not keeping urine





Outpatient Appropriate Antibiotic Use

- Only when **needed and if necessary**
 - Choosing the **right antibiotic**
 - In the **right dosage**
 - Prescribed in the **right time**
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Drug Interactions

- Ciprofloxacin and multivalent cations
- Apply at least 2 hours before or 6 hours later
