

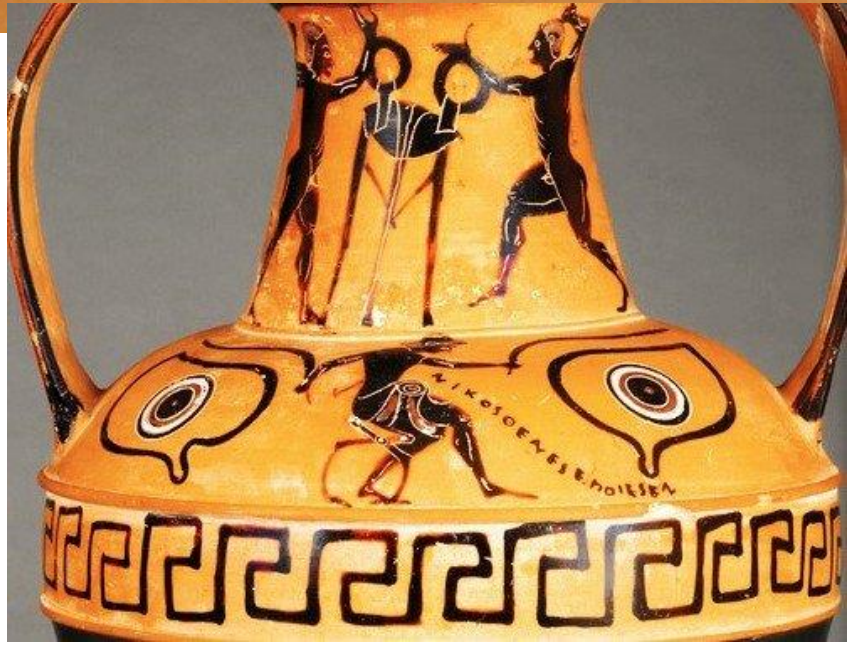

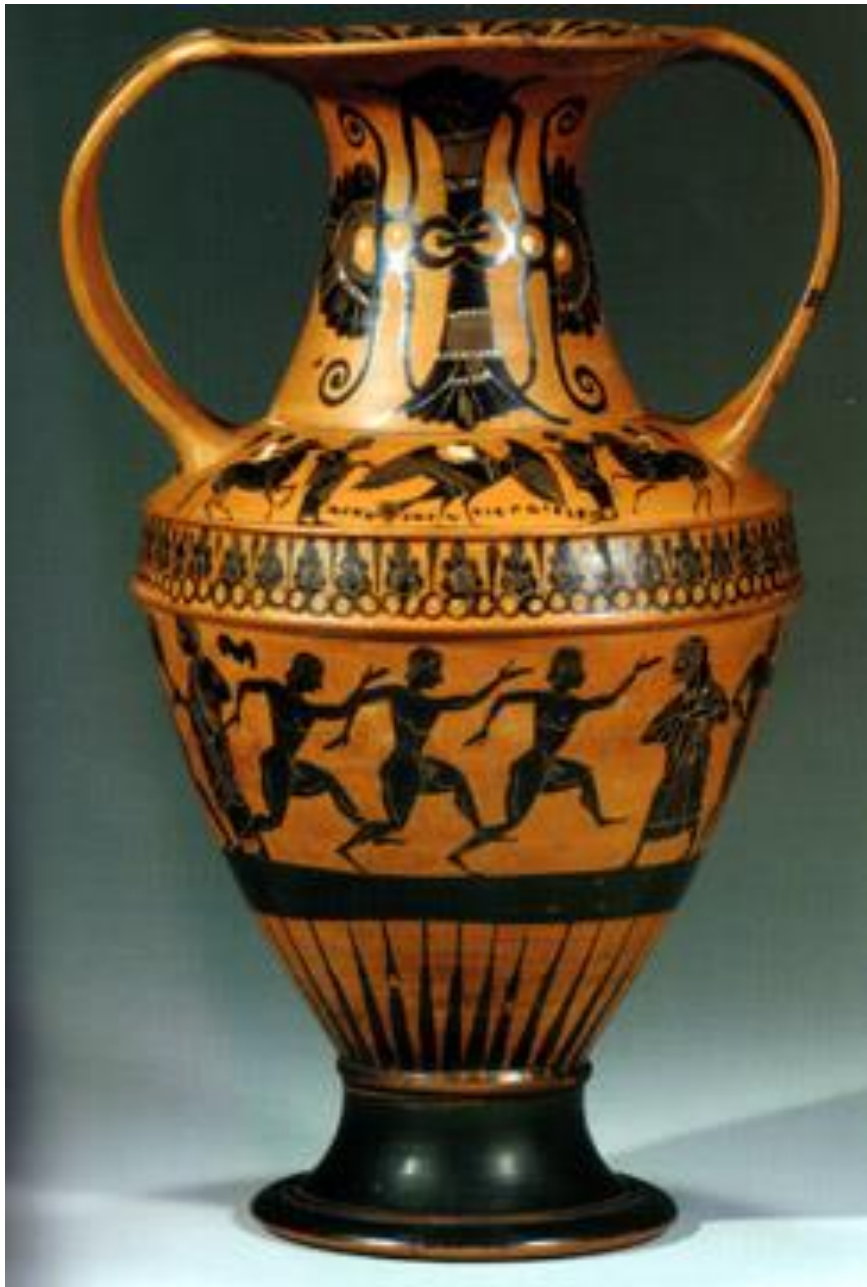

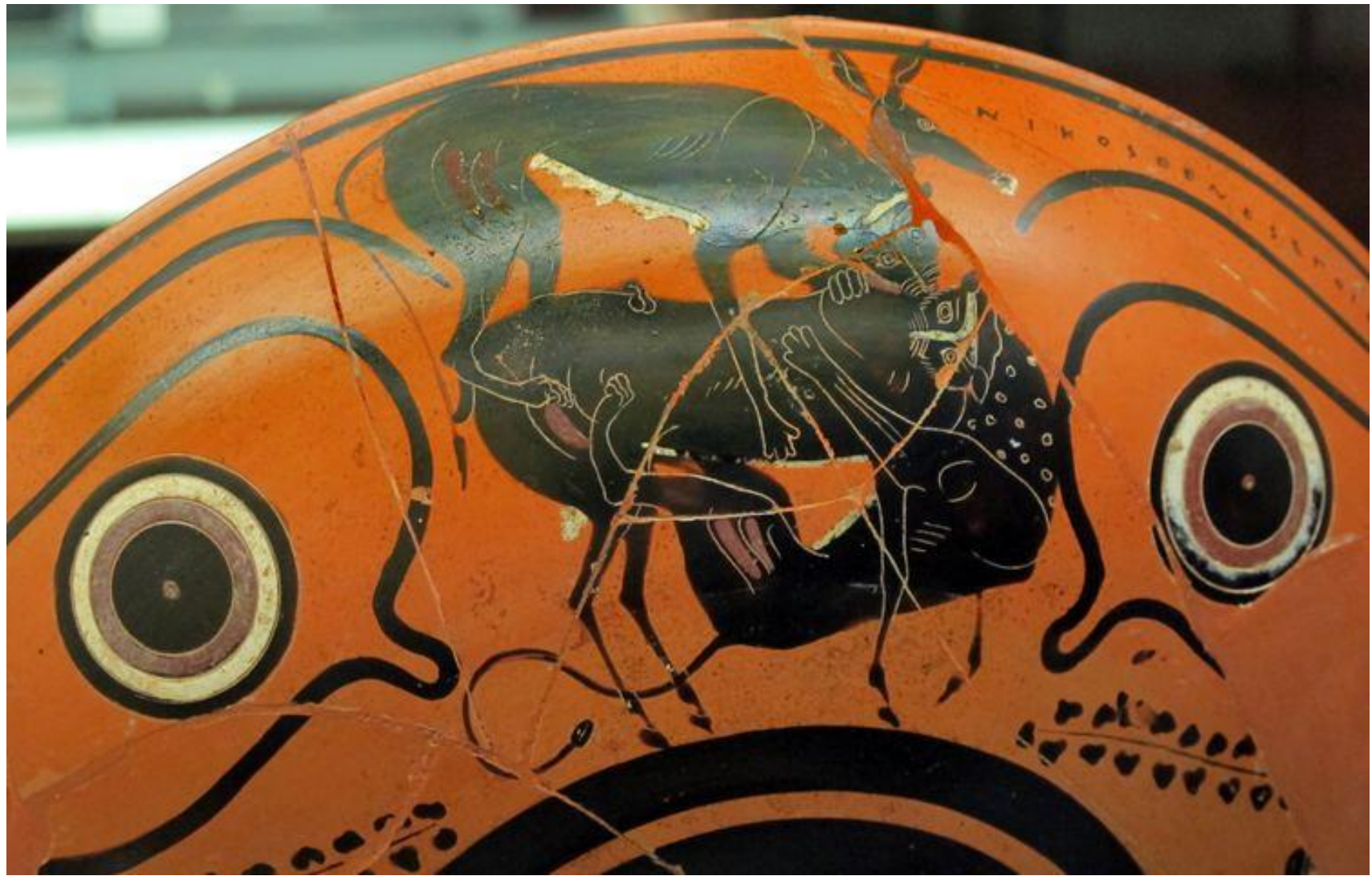


Black figured Nikosthenic neck #amphora

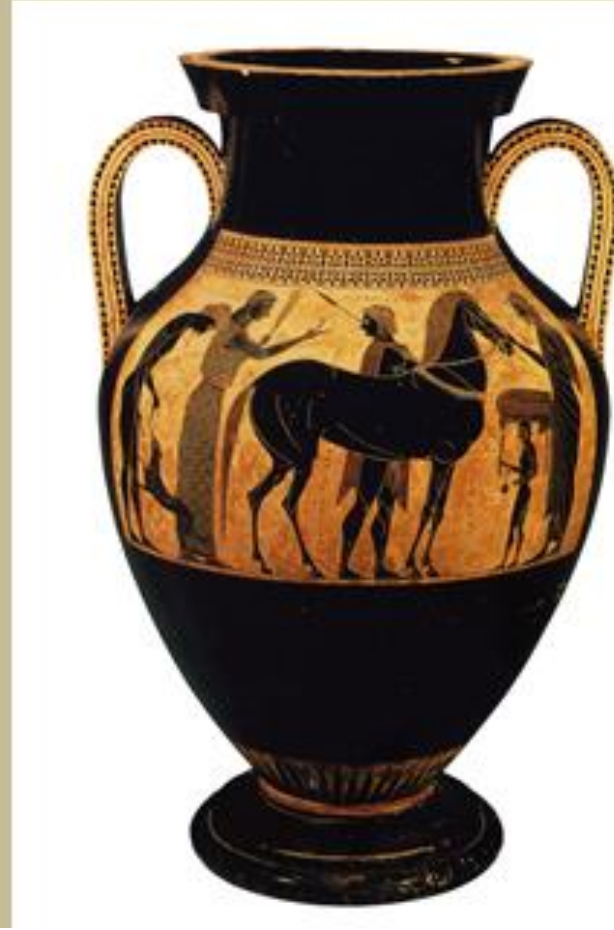

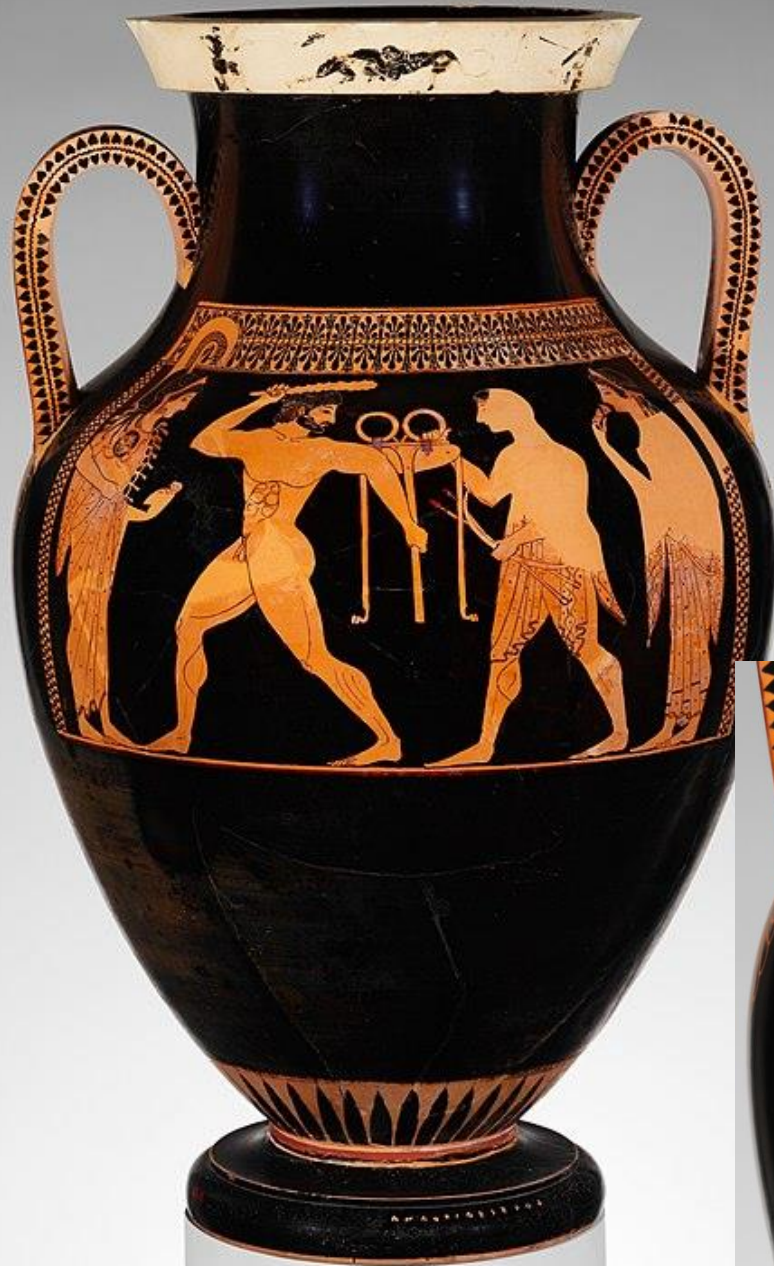


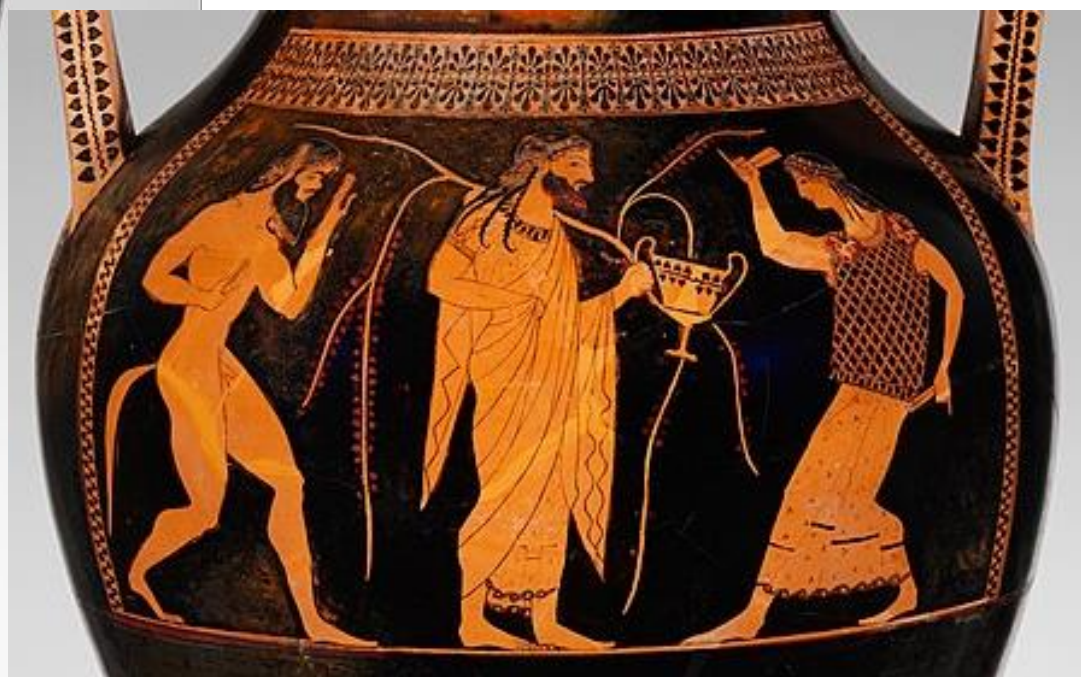

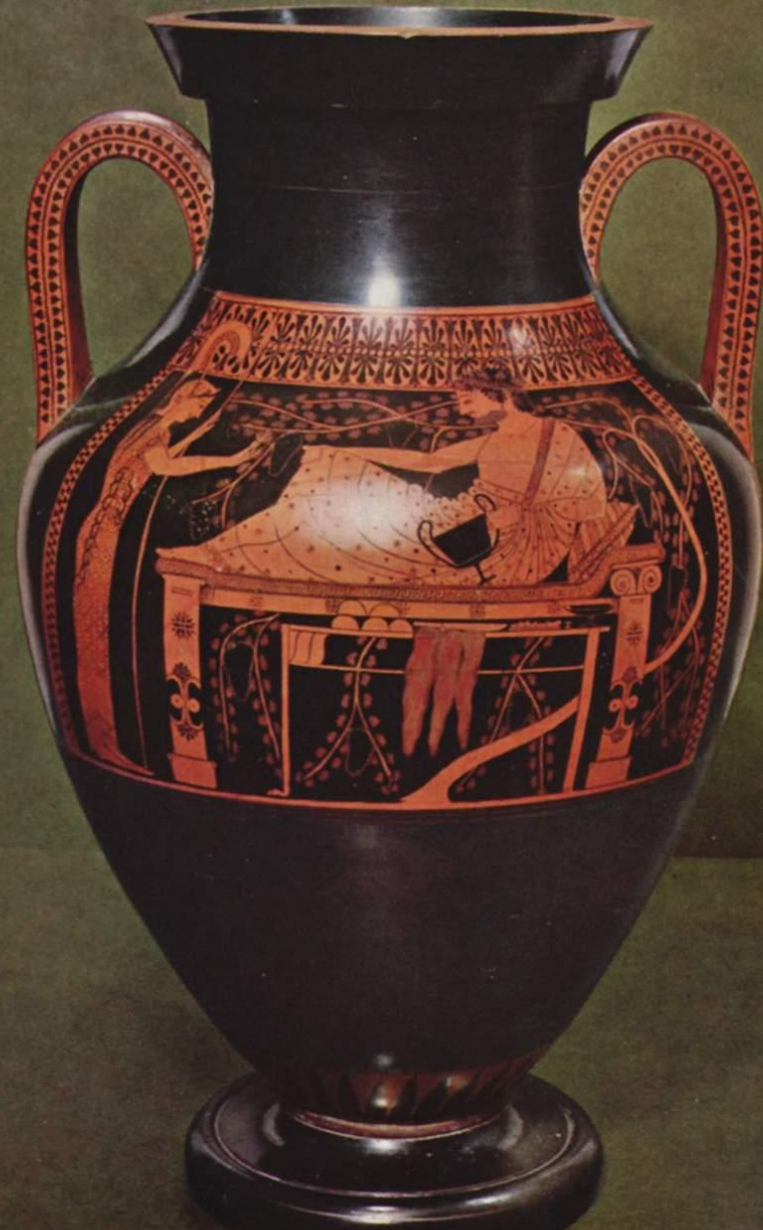
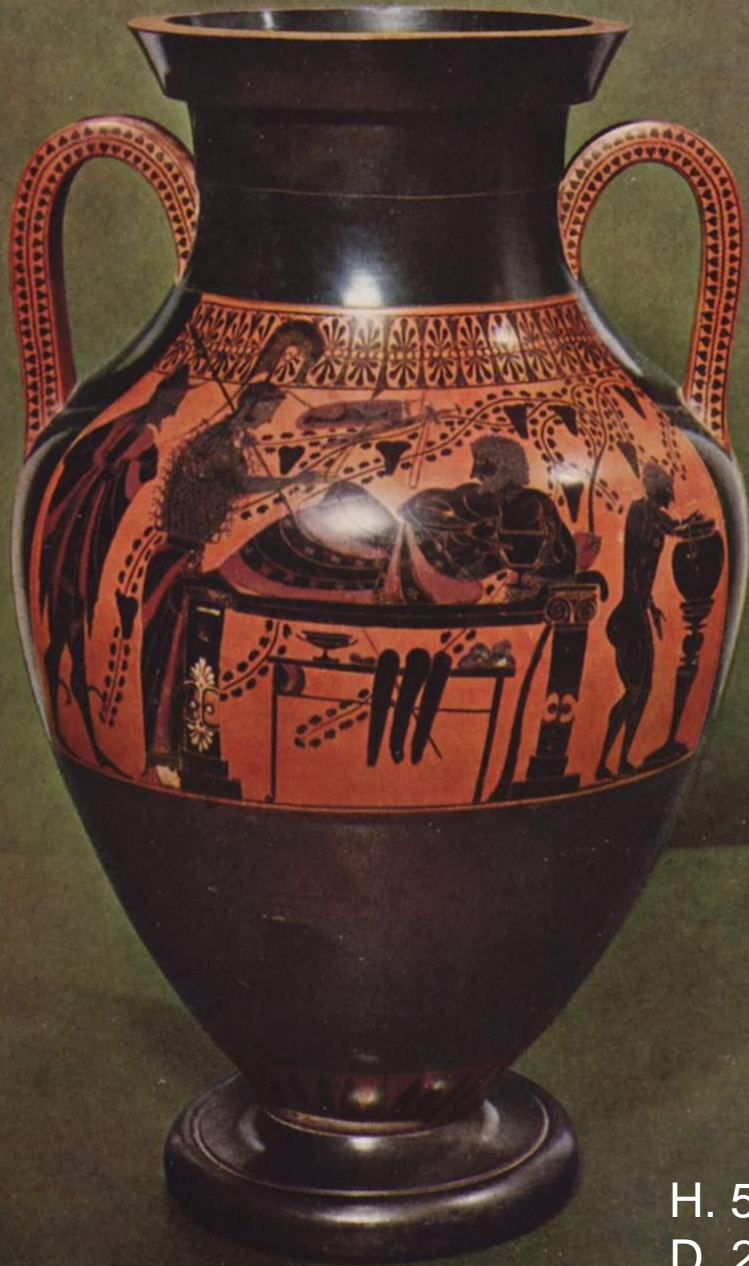

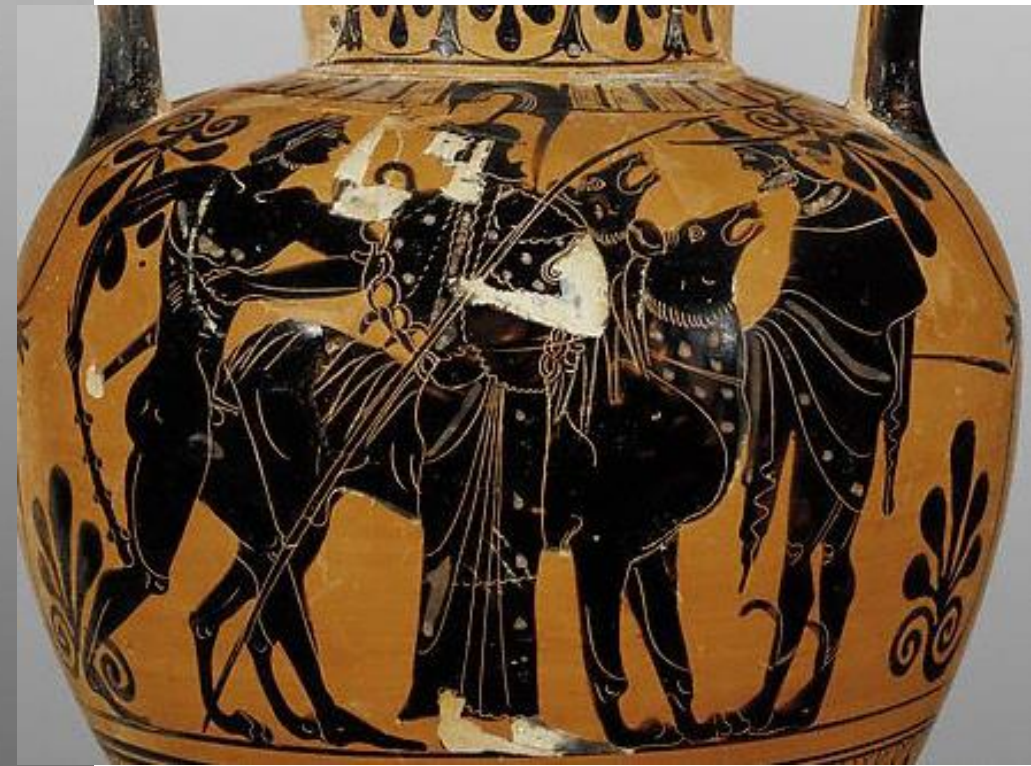

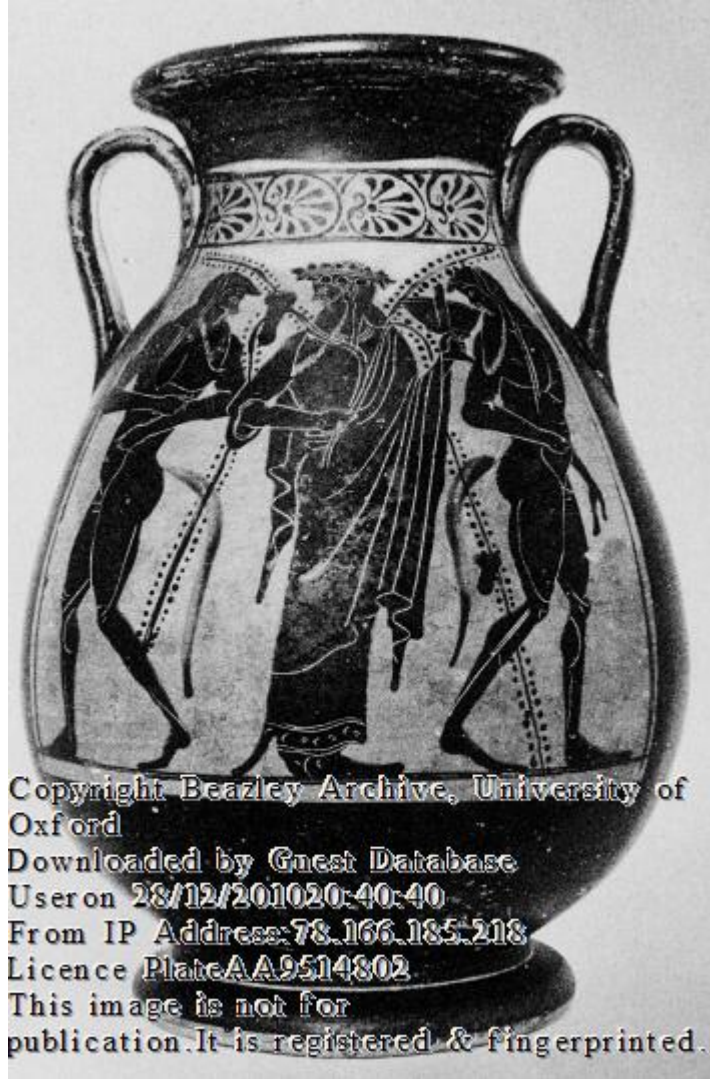
