



Red polished pottery is characteristic. Simple incised decorations can also be seen.



Talioti group of pottery is usually red slipped and not burnished. Pedestalled bowls is the most common shape.







EH II domestic architecture is usually rectangular in form. They have flat roofs and have hearths in the main room of the house. They usually have multi rooms.



Lerna: Stone foundation with mudbrich superstructure




Lithares: Wall construction



Some of the settlements are surrounded with fortifications. (Lerna, Askitario, Kolonna)




Only the Rundbau at Tiryns reflects a rather different plan.









FIGURE 2.7. Plan of the House of the Tiles at Lerna, EH IIB. After M. H. Wiencke,




FIGURE 2.8. Reconstruction of the House of the Tiles at Lerna, EH IIB. M. H.








FIGURE 2.7. Plan of the House of the Tiles at Lerna, EH IIB. After M. H. Wiencke,







FIGURE 2.3. Sauceboats from Lerna, EH II. J. L. Caskey, "The Early Helladic




