




Figure 18. Maurice Pillet, *Apadana Columns and Château*, 1913. Watercolor on paper, H. 14½ in. (37 cm). Coll. Mme. Étienne Pillet, Le Chesnay, France.




Figure 22. Maurice Pillet, *The Great Trench* (Jacques de Morgan's grande tranchée), 1913. Watercolor on paper, H. 19½ in. (49 cm). Coll. Mme. Étienne Pillet, Le Chesnay, France





Figure 23. Plan of the Acropole mound ca. 4000 B.C. showing Susa I structures and cemetery, by Frank Hole and Nicholas Kouchoukos










13 BOWL WITH GEOMETRIC DECORATION




PAINTED JAR WITH BIRDS IN FLIGHT

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






Figure 25. Drawing of a jar sealing. Sealing: Acropole, level 25
