Elaborating various theoretical accounts of crime, the course furnishes students with the skill of linking between sociological theorizing of crime and deviance and the sociohistorical context in which these theories emerged. The further knowledge in theories of crime, deviance and social control also builds up an ability to apply research evidence to understandings of crime related social problems and turns it into a vision of social policy.
