The **Domain Name System (DNS)** is a <u>hierarchical</u> decentralized naming system for computers, services, or other resources connected to the <u>Internet</u> or a private network. It associates various information with <u>domain names</u> assigned to each of the participating entities. Most prominently, it translates more readily memorized domain names to the numerical <u>IP addresses</u> needed for locating and identifying computer services and devices with the underlying network protocols.


