

DRAG-NET TRAWL FISHING

• Fishing made by trawling is made with kankava, tarata, tarlakoz, manyat, Igrip and trawl which can be taken to the ship by human power or mechanical force. These can be grouped into two main groups. The first group is the ones who are taken on the beach, the second group is the ones who are taken to the boat.




BEACH-SEINE

• Coastal and bottom structures are used in non-rocky areas, especially in the fishing of demersal fishes. It is usually used in the catch for red mullet, sole and sardine fish.







• The fishes collected by the fishermen are selected while the fishes are still alive and the small and worthless ones are thrown into the sea. Those in market size are taken to the land. The nets pulled back are collected again and stacked on the boat. The ropes are also gathered for the second time.
