

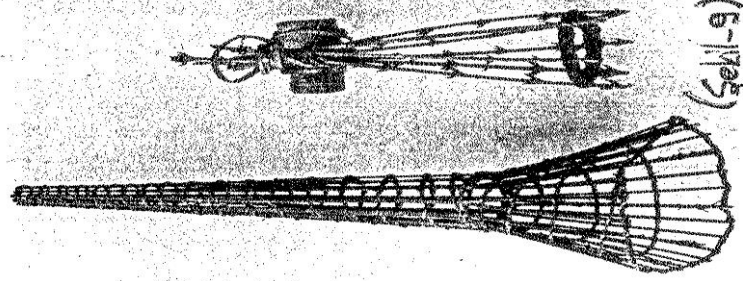

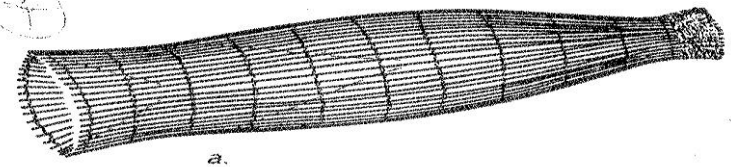
BASKETS, POTS

- The baskets are made of split reed, willow. There is a gate or funnel-shaped entrance to allow it to enter the fish. The shape and size of the baskets vary according to the nature of the fishin area and the type of fish to be caught.
- The baskets are usually built on the one by one. But sometimes a large number of baskets are arranged in a line.

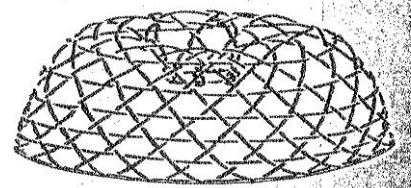

OCTOPUS POT

- It is usually reddish orange color and vase shaped pots. The width of the gutters is 10 cm and the height is 24 cm. A large number of pots can be connected with the help of the main rope, the branch rope which can be as long as 200 m. Sometimes up to 120 pots can be found on a set.

FYKE-NET

- It is called "Pinter" for the fishing tools prepared after the conical structure nets attached to metal or wooden hoops are intertwined and the hoops are covered with net. It is commonly used in shallow sections of the sea, lake, and rivers. Sea bass, octopus, eel and sparidae species are caught.
