#### **Planum Medianum**

- An animal standing on four legs is the plane assumed to pass vertically in the direction of the head-tail, right at the center. The body separates the left and right half.

- It is assumed that an archer holding a bow is named inspired from the position of posture and passes parallel to the planum medianum.
- It divides the whole body in and out according to the planum medianum's closeness.

#### **Planum Transversum**

- An animal standing on four legs is a planet medianum and every plane perpendicular to the long axis of the body and the orbital. It divides the body into front and back.

- Rostrum; beak
- Cranium; head
- Cauda; queue
- proximal; Proximity (near the body)
- Proximus (It): closest
- distal; Distant (away from the body)

#### **Planum Horizontale**

- An animal standing on four legs is the plane (Planum dorsale, Planum Frontale), which is perpendicular to the planum medianum but supposed that the body passes parallel to the long axis of the body organs [parallel to the horizon].
- It divides the body upside down.
