Osteology

- **Bone**; Os (Lt.), Osteon (Gr.)
- *** Os is also used in the mouth sense.
- (Eg ostium, mouth, entrance, opening, hole)
- **Science**; Logie

Part of the Bones

- * Periosteum (**peri**, around)
- * Substantia ossea (**substance**, substance)
 - Substantia compacta (**compact**, compact)
 - Substantia spongiosa (**spongiose**, sponge)
- * Cavum medullare (**cavum**, space, medulla, marrow)
- * Endosteum (**endo**; internal)
- * Medulla ossea
 - Medulla ossium rubra (**ruber**; red)
 - Medulla ossium flava (**flavis**; yellow)
- Epiphysis (**Epi**, proximal and distal part)
- Metaphysis (**Meta**, meanwhile, in the middle)
- Diaphysis (**Dia**; main, trunk)

Extremitas

- **Extremities; Most extreme, farthest = Gr. Akros (acr-); Tip, far edge**
 - **Scapula (Gr. Scapein, dig, shovel)**
 - *** acromion; (Gr. Acros, most extreme, Gr. Osmos, shoulder)**
 - *** coracoid; corax (crow - crow 's hook = hook, hook)**
 - *** glenoid; shallow pit shape (Gr.**
 - *** hamatus; hook**
 - **clavicula; in the form of keys (Clavis,)**
 - **(H) umerus, shoulder) (used for shoulder in the past)**
 - **Brachi (brachium, arm)**
 - **Radius; wheel arch**
 - **Ulna; elbow (Gr. olene: ; elbow)**
- olecranon; elbow (Grant, elbow, cranus, cap, helmet = olenokranon)**

- **Carpus (wrist)**

- **Phalanx (Gr.); Soldiers lined up side by side**

Extremitas

- **Cox; Pelvic bones (Coxa, Hip, PI-coxae)**
- **Ilium; Coxa's largest bone, the wing bone (hip)**
- **pubis; inguinal**
- **Ischii (Pocket-shaped) (Now used for acetabulum)**
- **Acetabulum; Small vinegar case (bowl with 270 ml capacity)**
- **Foramen obturatum; Closed hole (Obturare, closing, blocking)**
- **Femina; Thigh bones (Femur; But)**
- **Patella; (Patina - Pan, pans, plates)**
- **Tibia; Shin bone (Tibia)**
- **Fibula; Needle bone**
- **Tarsus Ankle (wrist)**
- **talus; Fallen bone (Talutium, inclination, inclination)**
- **calcaneus; Heel bone (calcem, heel)**
