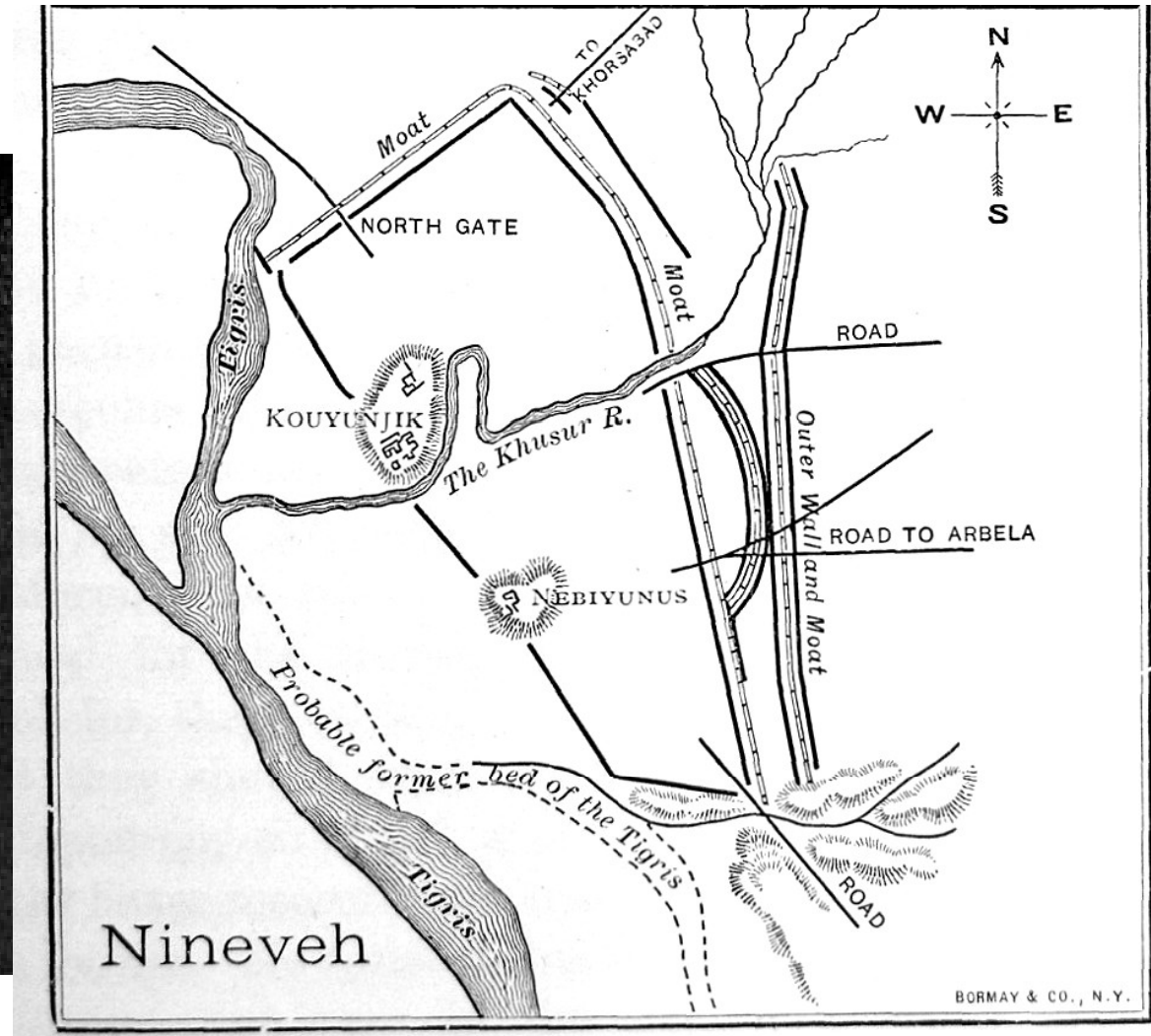

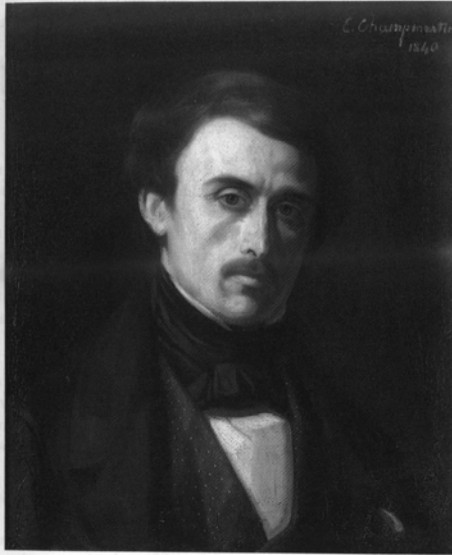
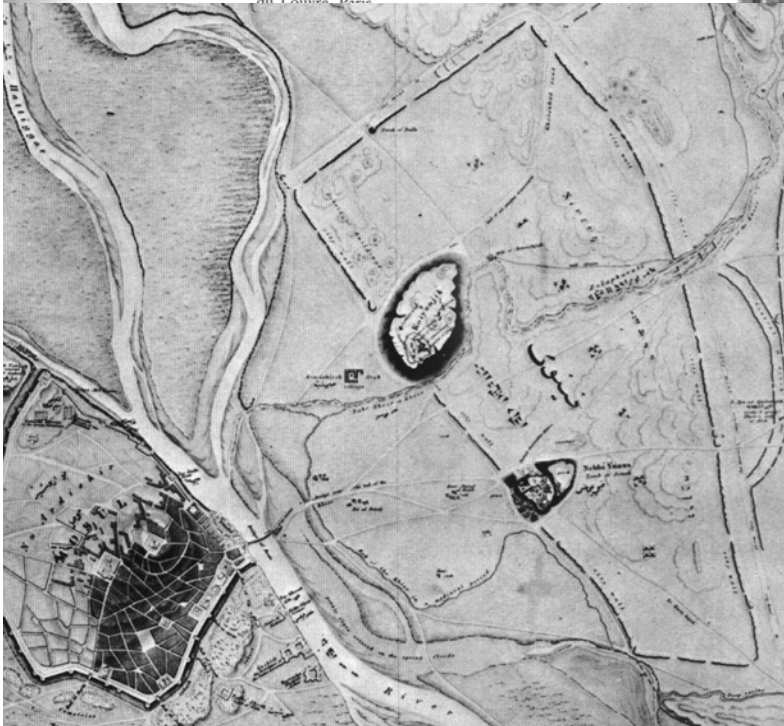


Figure 2.1 C.-E. Champmartin's painting of Paolo Emilio Botta, from 1840 which shows him shortly before he left for Mosul. As far as I know, this is the only portrait of Botta, and it now hangs in the office of Dr Annie Caubet who is in charge of the department of ancient Near Eastern archaeology at the Louvre. Reproduced by courtesy of the Musée du Louvre, Paris.







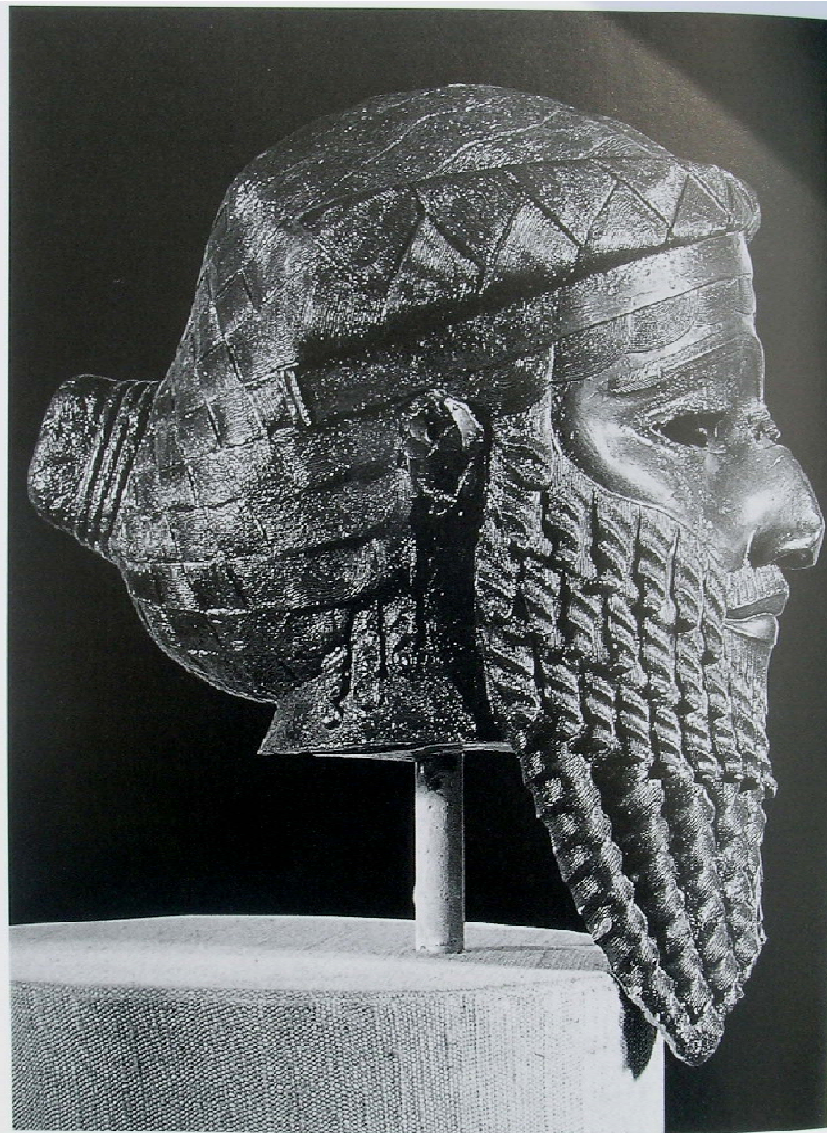


Fig. 57. Copper-alloy head of a ruler. Nineveh, Akkadian, ca. 2300–2159 B.C.  
Iraq Museum, Baghdad, IM 11331.





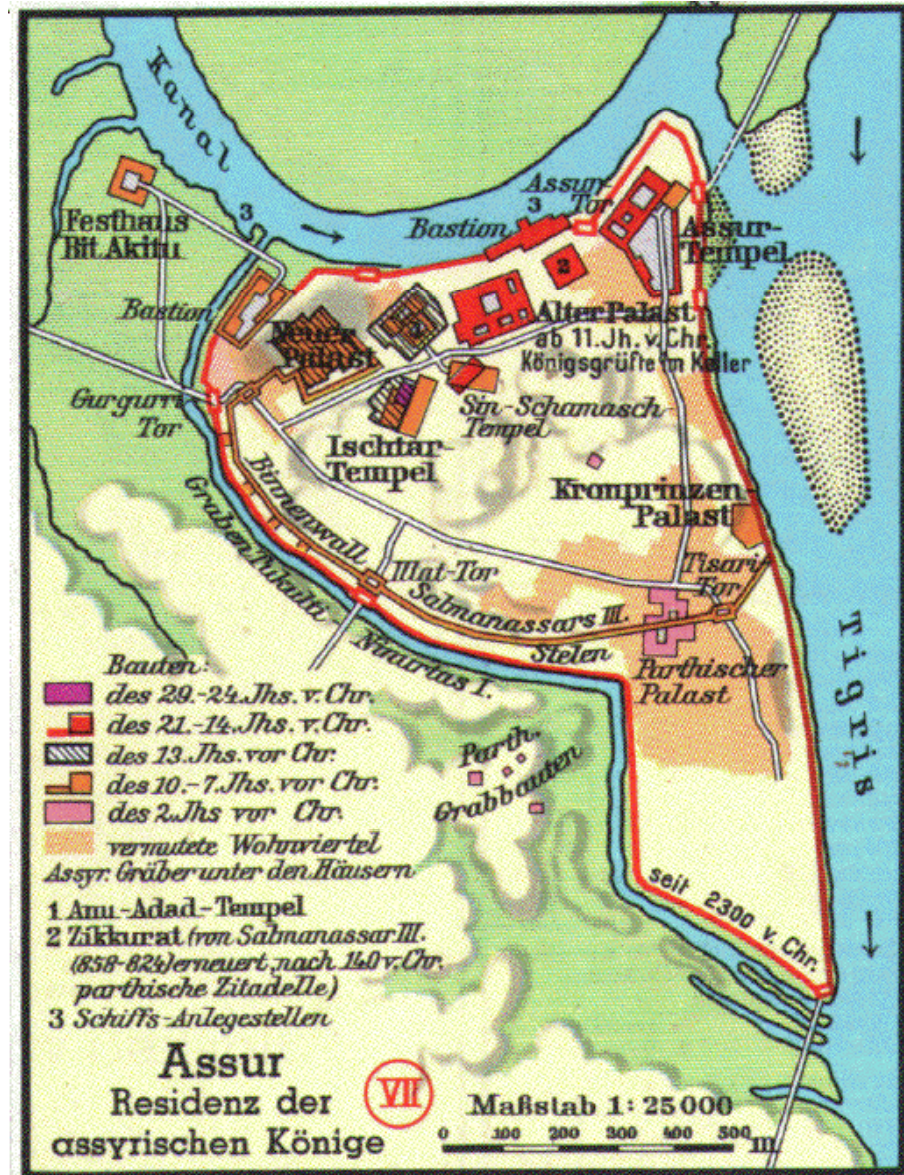




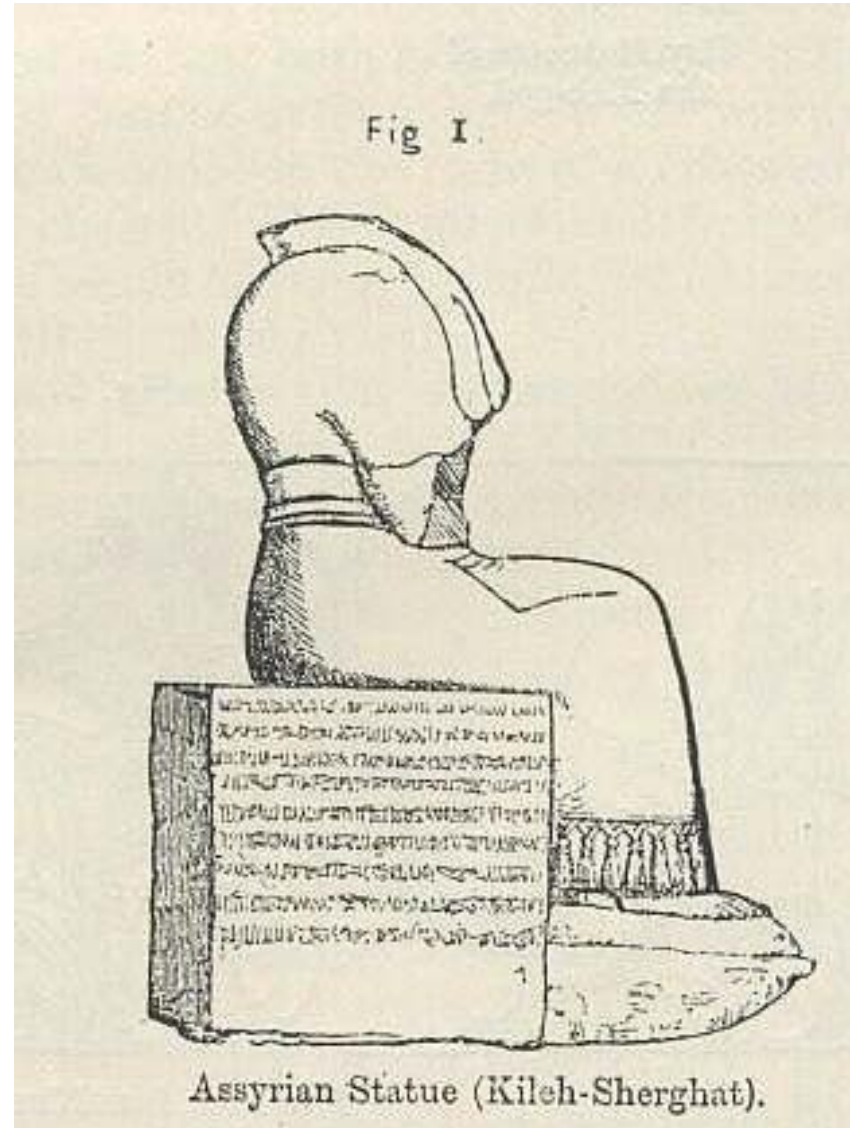




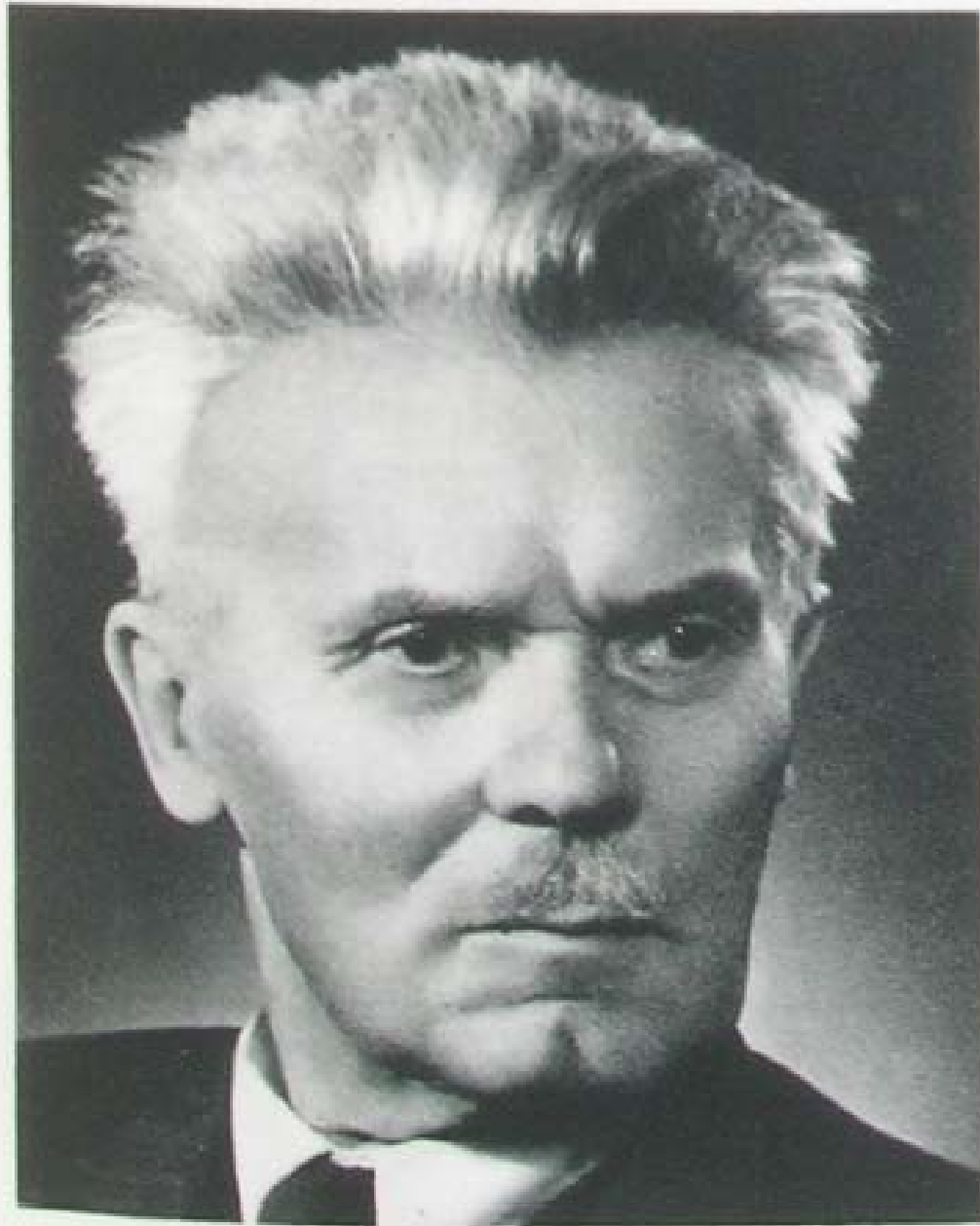
