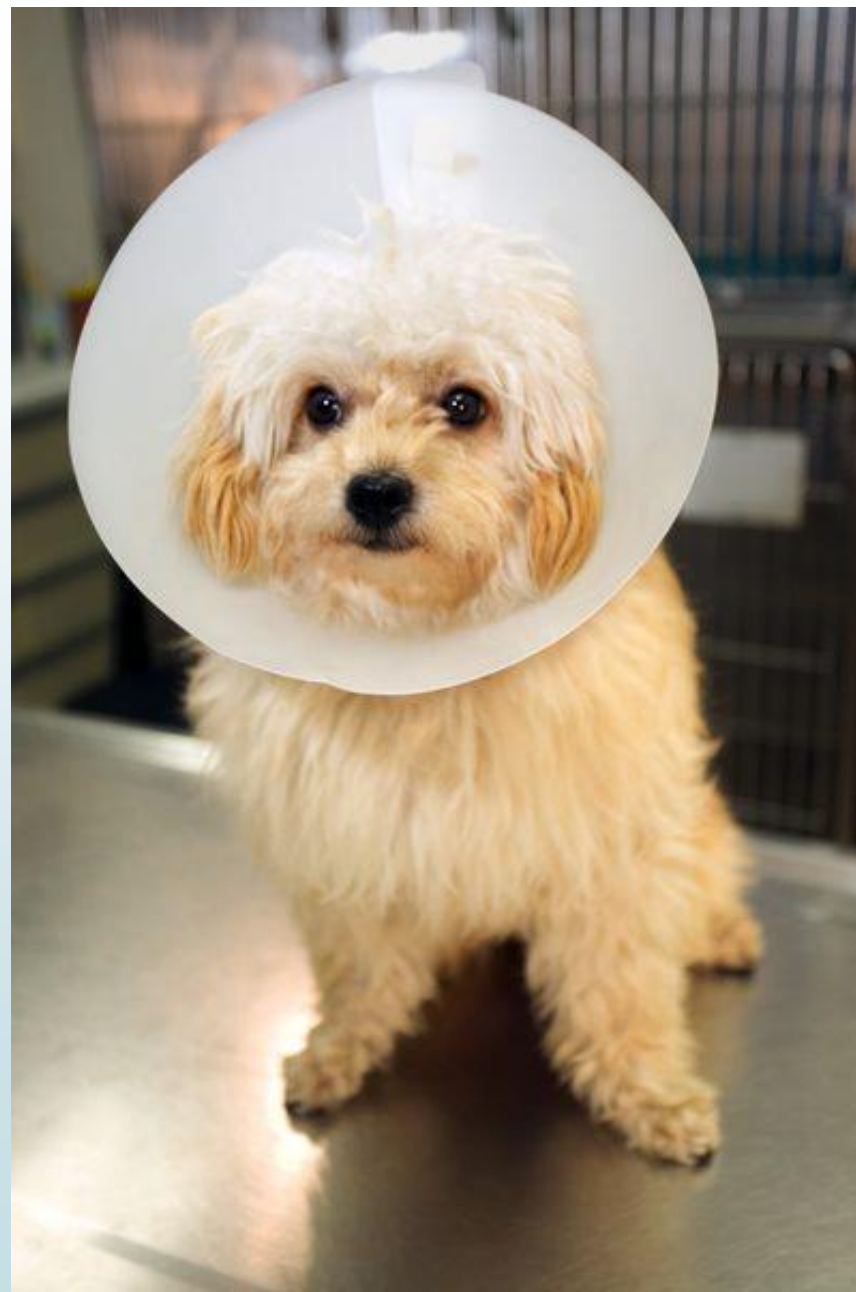

Better restraint:

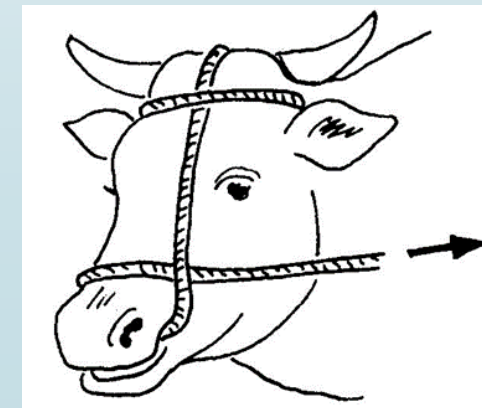
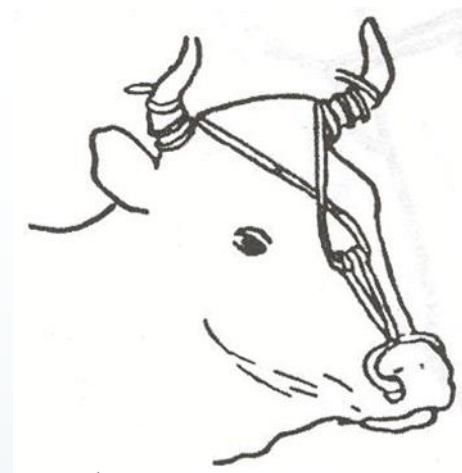
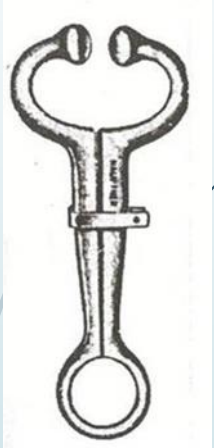
1. Protects you from bite and scratching

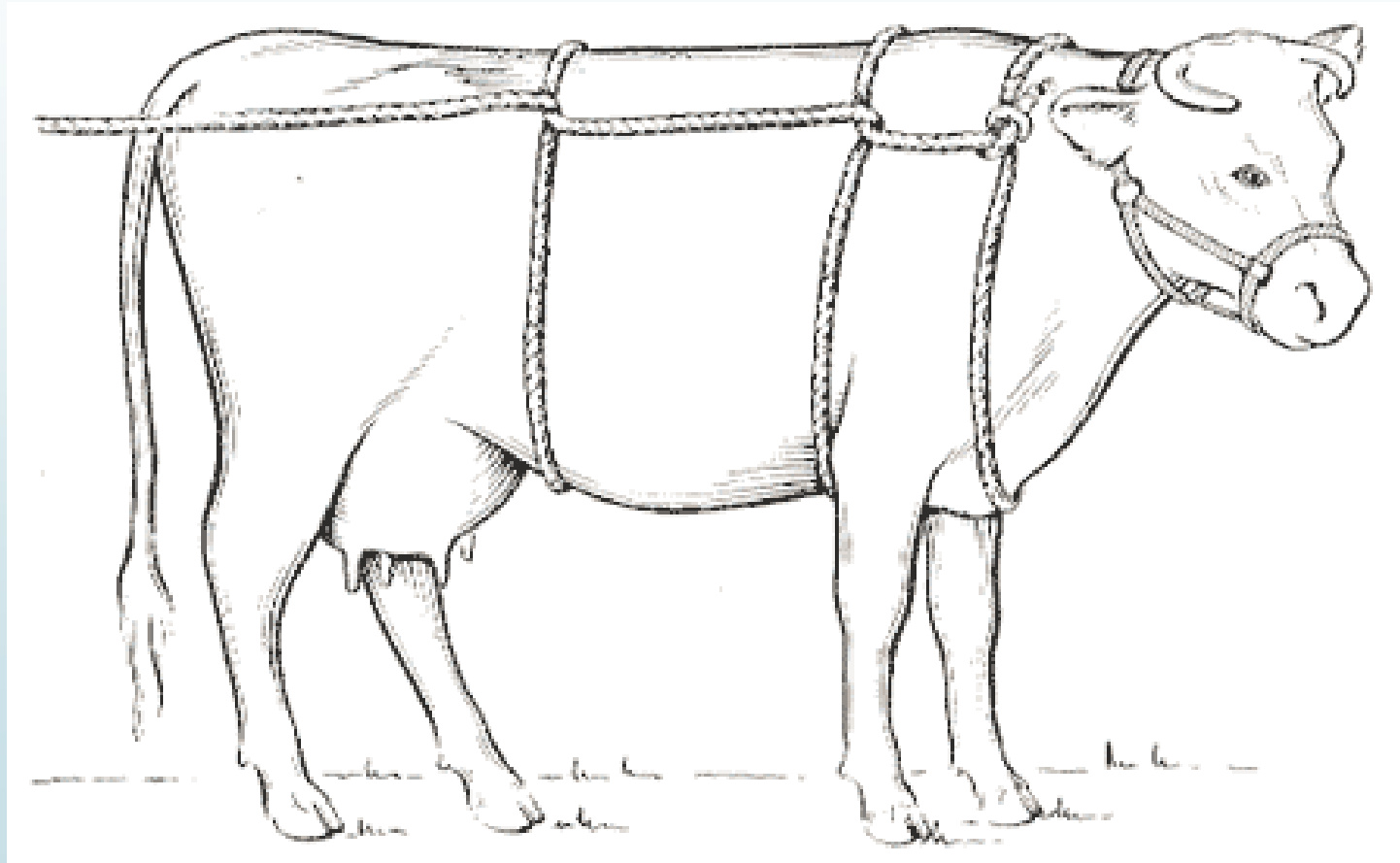

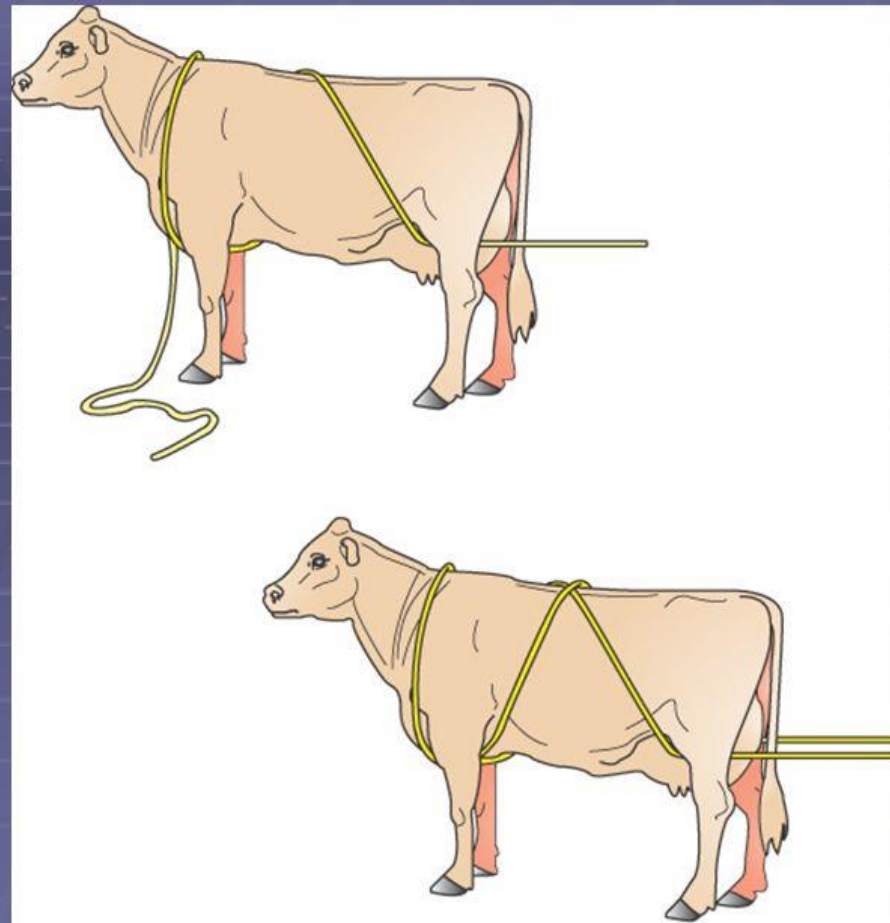
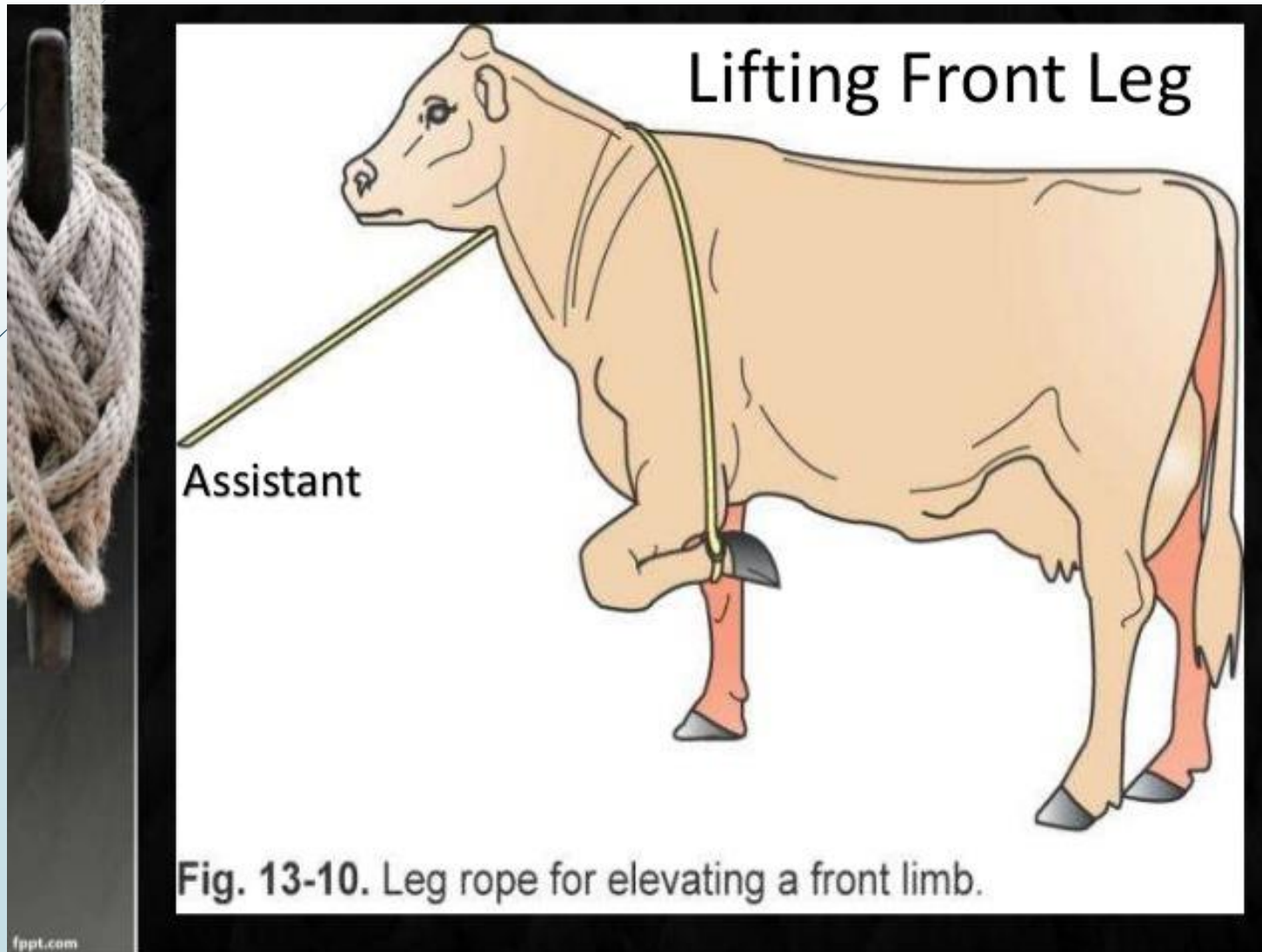


Fig. 13-13. The Burley casting harness. Pulling on the two free ends of the rope forces the cow to lie down.
