- ☐ Head is the most important part of the body. The organs and specific structures are located on the head such as brain, eyes, ears, nose and sinuses, oral cavity and salivary glands.

 - Skin
 - Superficial Muscles
 - Vessels and nerves
 - Bone (cranium)

Guttural pouch

- Large mucous sac which is ventral diverticulum of tubae auditivae on dorsal surface of the pharynx
