



The concept of large-scale sculpture and style of the face show inspiration from the East Mediterranean. but details of the clothing and jewellery are Etruscan.







Etruscan terracotta figures, Tomb of the Five Chairs, 600 BCE, Cerveteri, Italy, British Museum






470-460 ac.ca., Pyrgi Pediment. Altorilievo del frontone
