Week 7 - Circulatory system of fish

- Closed type of circulatory system is found in fishes.
- Blood is reddish in color due to the presence of hemoglobin.
- Hemoglobin is found in erythrocytes. Thrombocytes are useful in blood clotting.
- Heart in fishes is two chambered with an auricle and ventricle.
- It is known as venous heart due to the circulation of only impure blood.
- Arterial and venous systems are developed in fishes.
- Hepato portal system is developed in fishes.
