İmparator Titulaturaları

Maxentius 306 - 312 CE AE Follis
Obv: laureate bust right
Rev: Castor and Pollux facing holding spears and horses' reins.
Ostia mint.



Pièce de monnaie en or datant de l'Empereur Trajan (98-117). Depuis Auguste, seuls les empereurs peuvent frapper (produire) de la monnaie en or.



Traiano (Trajan coins often have his adopted father's name before = N, NER, NERVA, or NERVAE), followed by titles gained from successful military campaigns

(**GER** - Germany, **DAC** - Dacia). Later Parthico was added for his campaign against Parthia.

PM - PONTIFEX MAXIMUS - Highest priest of the Roman religion.

TR P - TRIBUNICIA POTESTATE - Tribune of the Roman people.



COS V = Fifth Consulship - CONSUL - The consuls were the chief magistrates of the Roman government with two appointed each year. This is a very useful tool for dating coins of Trajan.

PP = PATER PATRIAE - Father of his country

SPQR = Senatus Populusque Romanus (The Senate and People of Rome).


OPTIMO PRINC = The greatest ruler (another special title bestowed to Trajan).

Early coins of the Empire usually do not have inscriptions in the exegue.

In this case **DAC CAP** = Dacia in Captivity.




- Roman Empire by death of Augustus, A.D. 14




