## 2.2.3. ABOUT VERBAL WORD FORMATION

## 2.2.3.1. -ahh-, -annāi-, -eš-, -šš- and -nu-

Verbs can be produced with a number of productive suffixes. Denominal are the factitive suffix *-ahh-* and the fientive suffix *eš-*, deverbal the durative suffix *-annāi-* and the intensive suffix *-šš-*; with the causative suffix *-nu-* new verbs can be formed both from verbs and nouns. All these derived verbs can produce further *-šk*-formations which will be treated in the following chapter.
