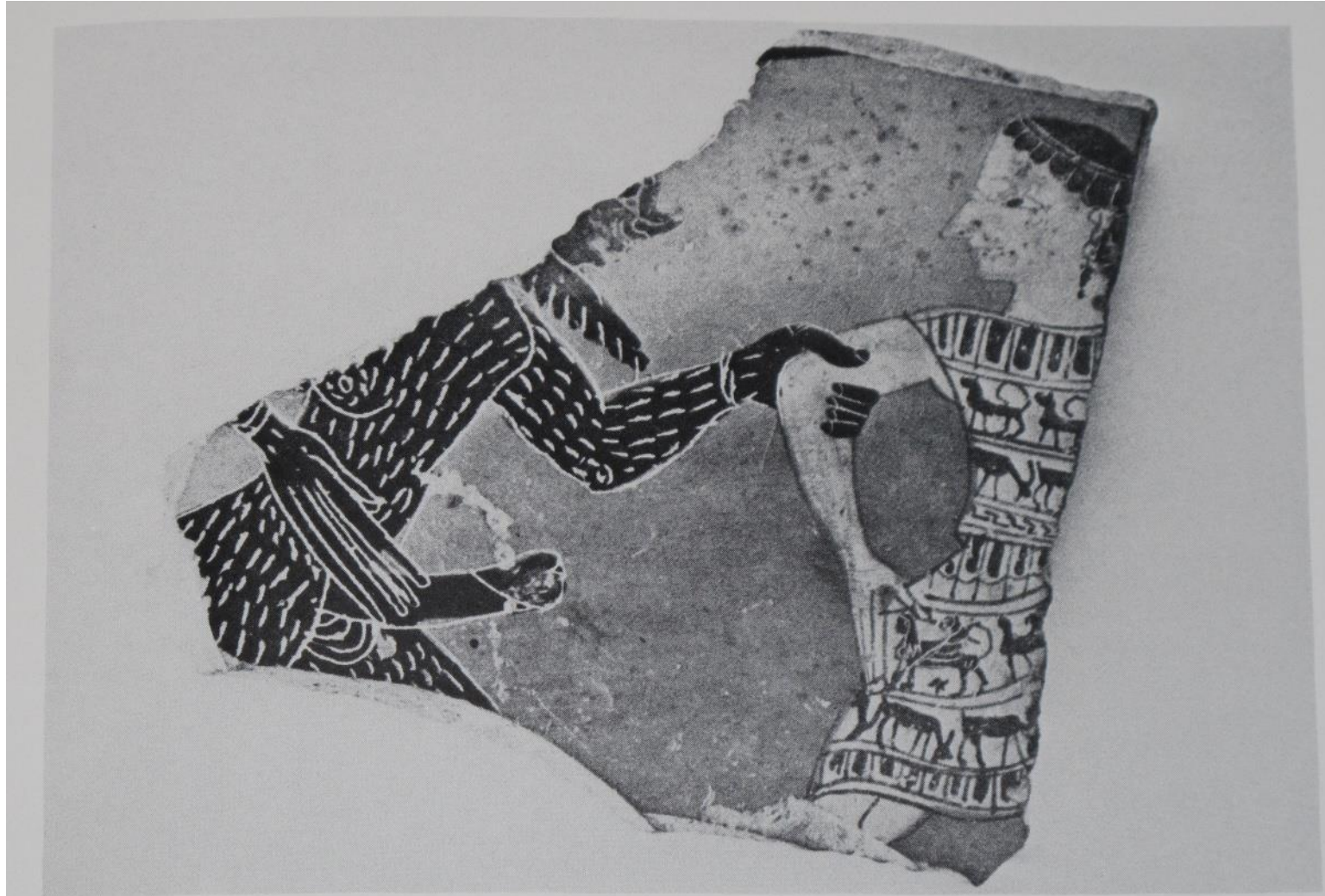

Attic black-figure amphora. Late work of the vase-painter Sophilos, ca. 580 B.C. On the neck Hermes, between Sphinxes. On the body zones decorated with winged Artemis, animals, florals, sphinxes, geese. Found at Marathon, in the tumulus of the Athenians (490 B.C.)

Sophilos is the first known artist from the Athenian potters' quarter to have signed his name on his work—once as potter and three times as painter. This early form of the volute-krater is decorated in front with two boars and in back with a bull with another animal.
