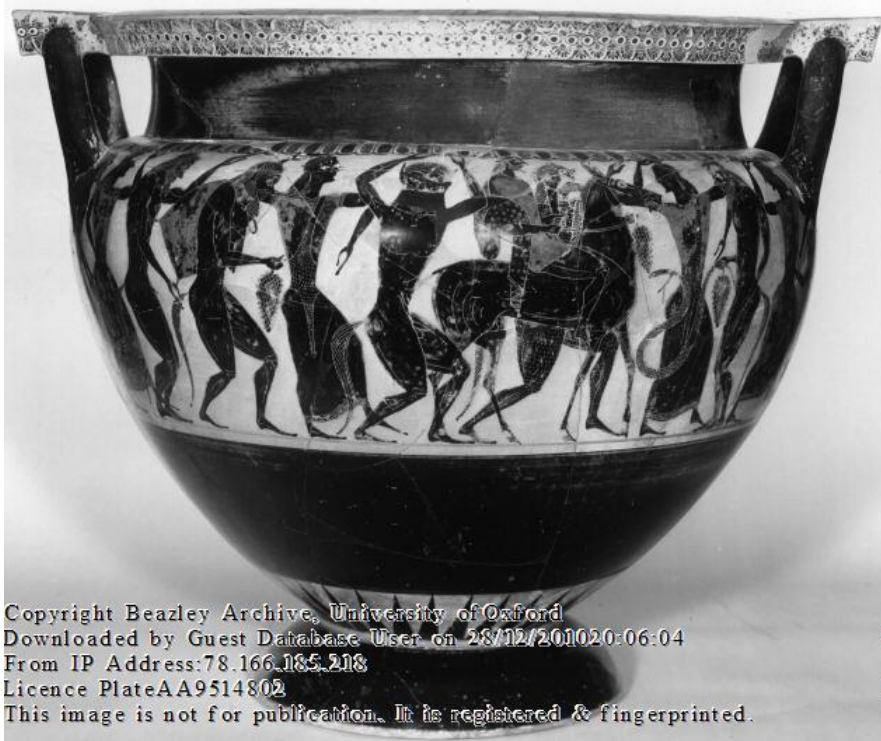

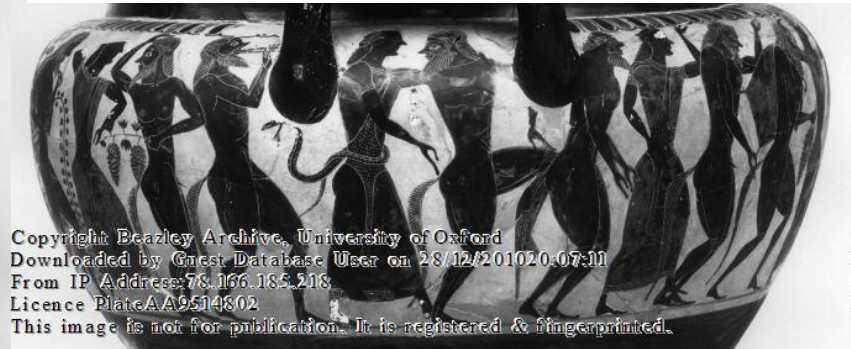
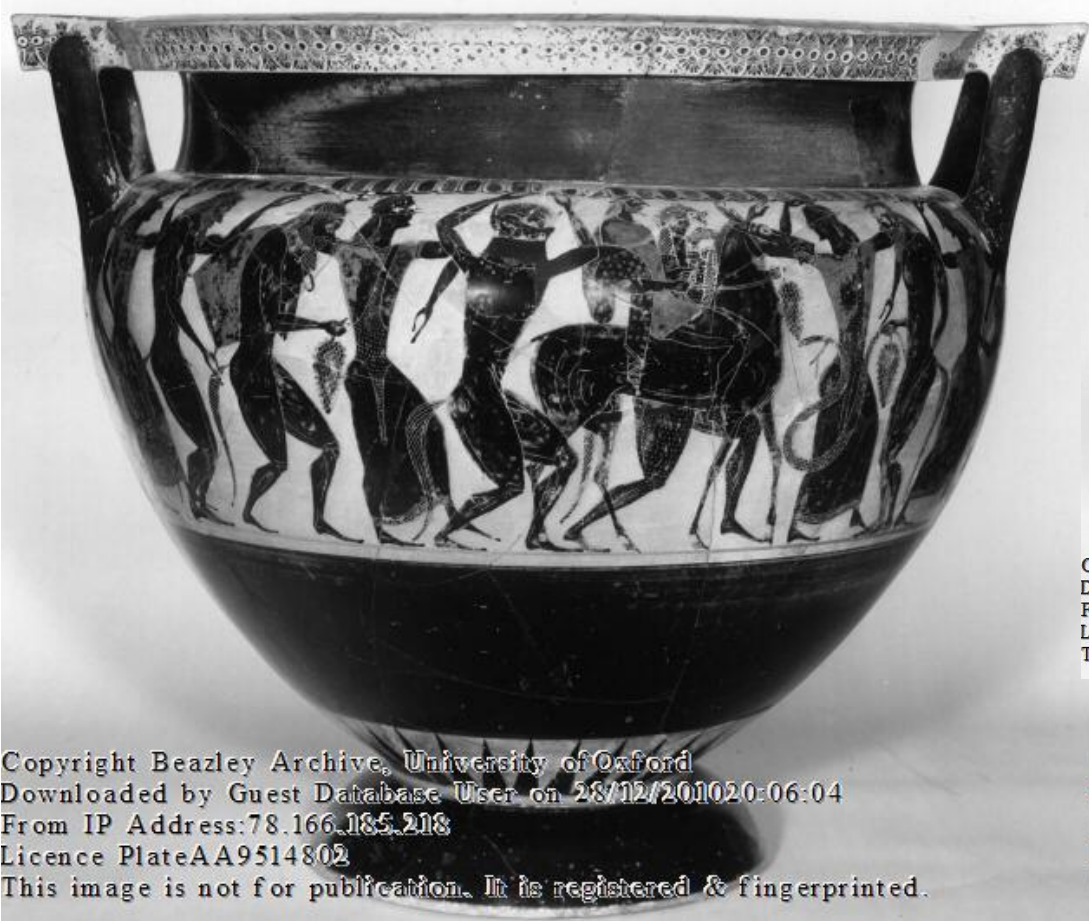
Terracotta column-krater (bowl for mixing wine

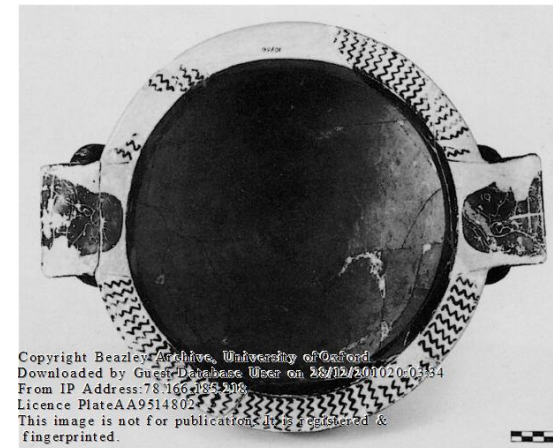

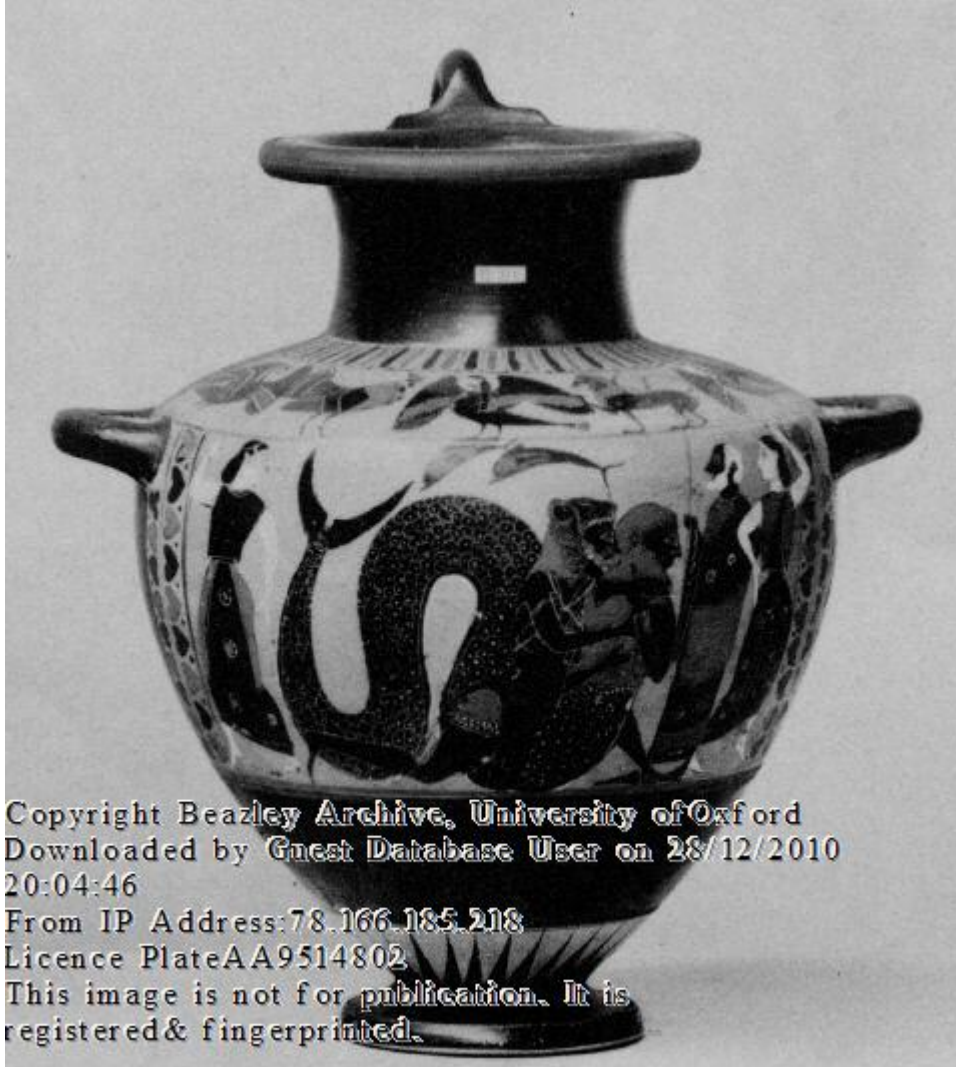


Warrior departure, Louvre

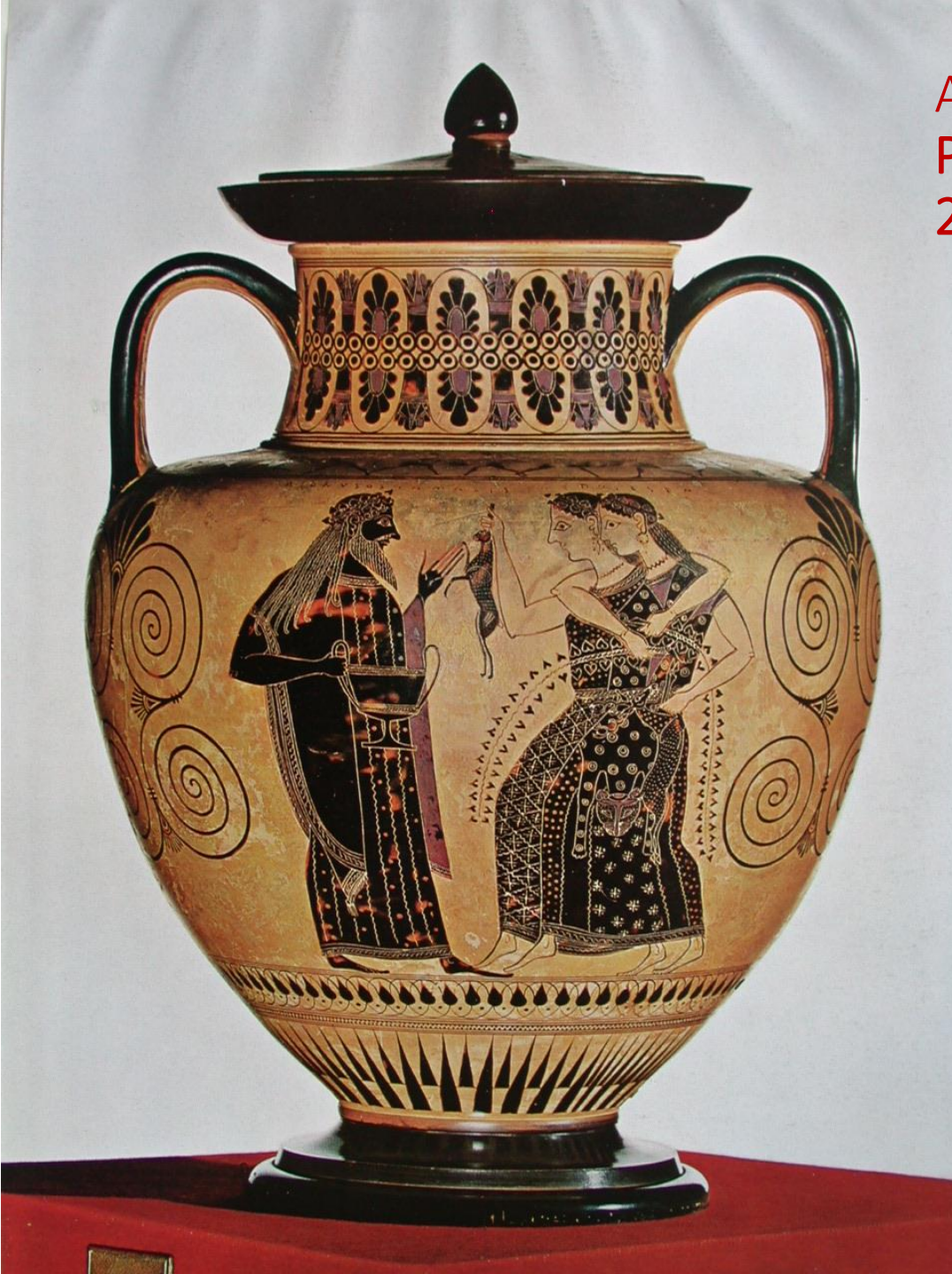

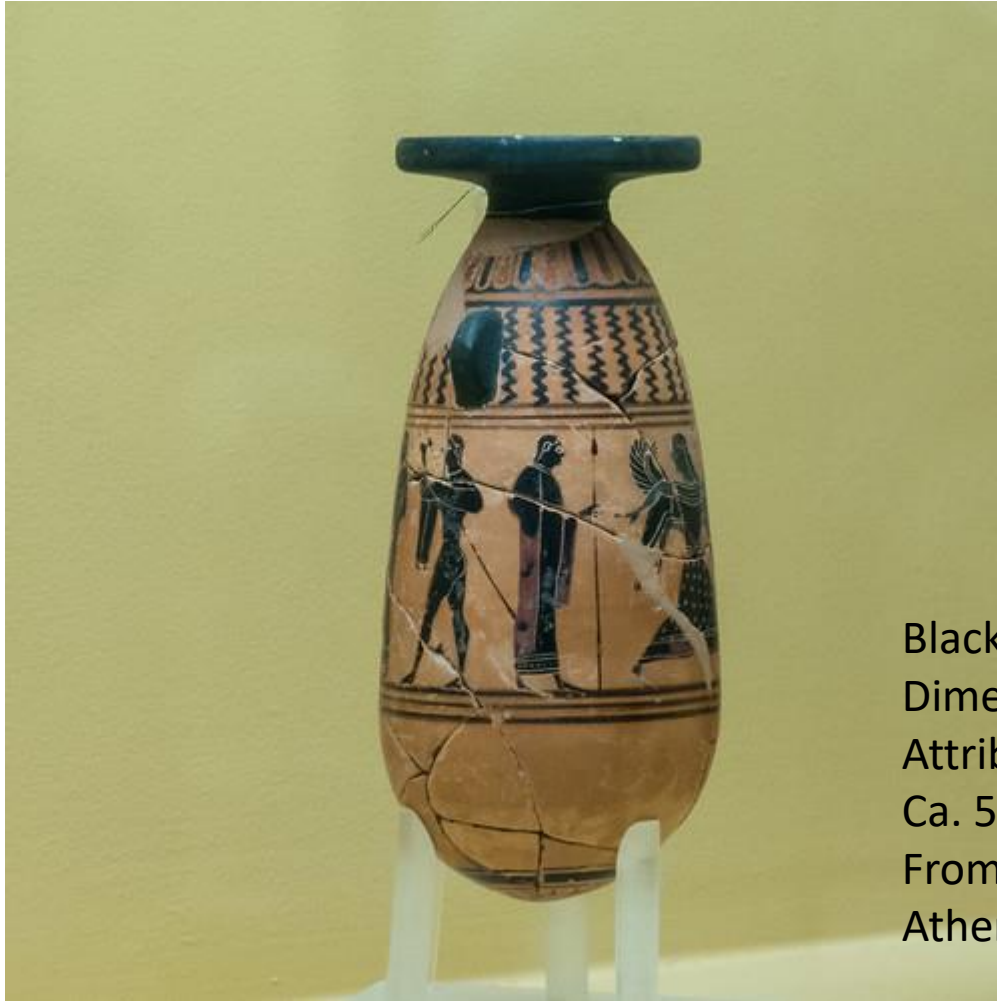

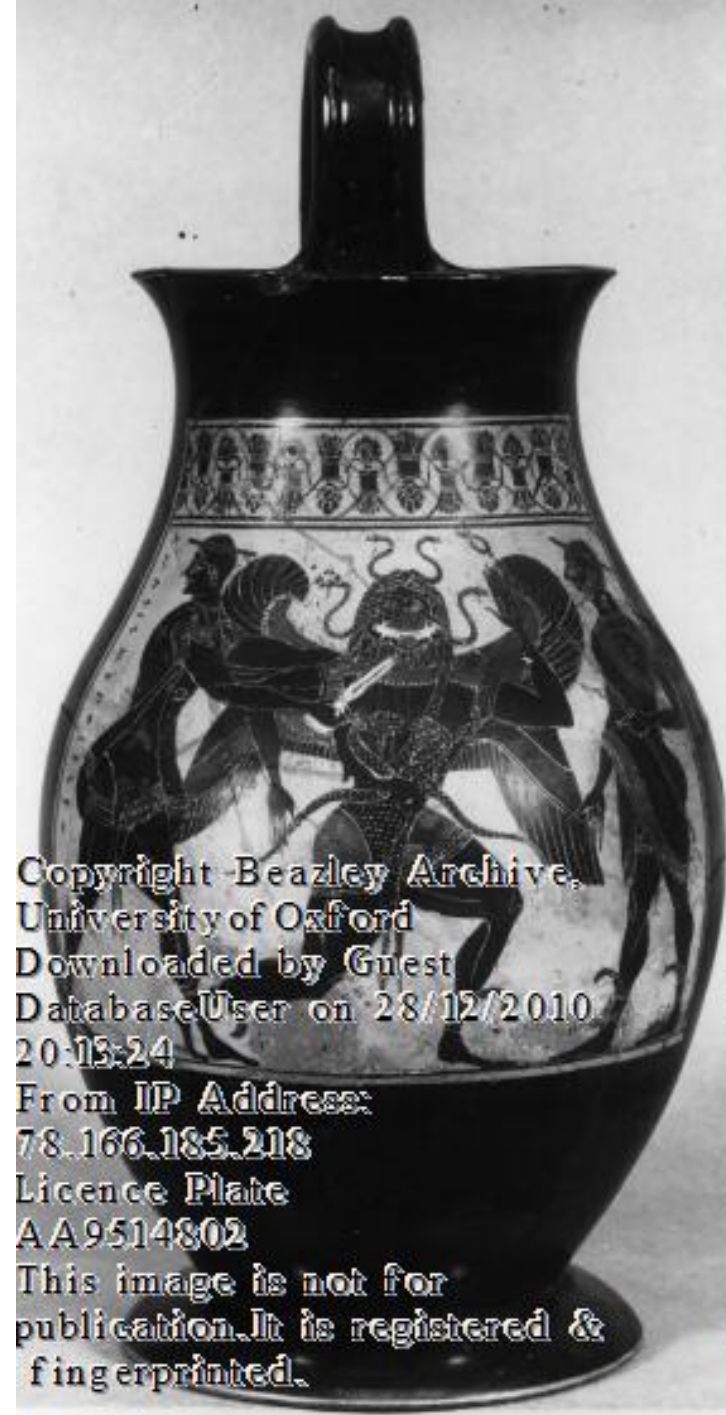
