- Puppies and kitties gain antibodies from their mother by milk
- These are called maternal antibodies
- These lasts for only first weeks
- Puppies usually have a course of 3 vaccinations
- These are normally given 4 weeks apart
- 1st vaccines (first vaccination) at 6-8 weeks
- 2nd vaccines (first booster) at 10-12 weeks
- 3rd vaccines (final vaccination) at 14-16 weeks
- When your puppy is at 1 year old adult vaccinations
