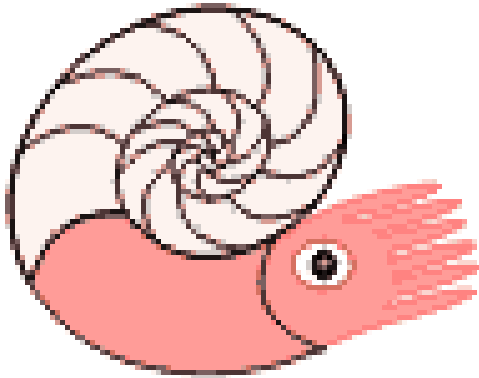


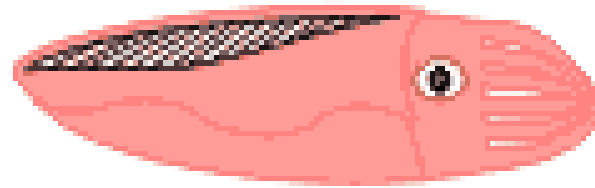

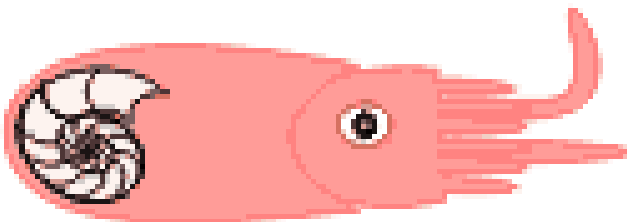
4. The cuttlefish *Sepia*



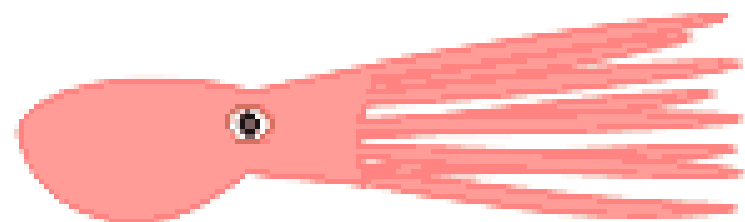
2. A belemnite (extinct)



5. The squid *Loligo*

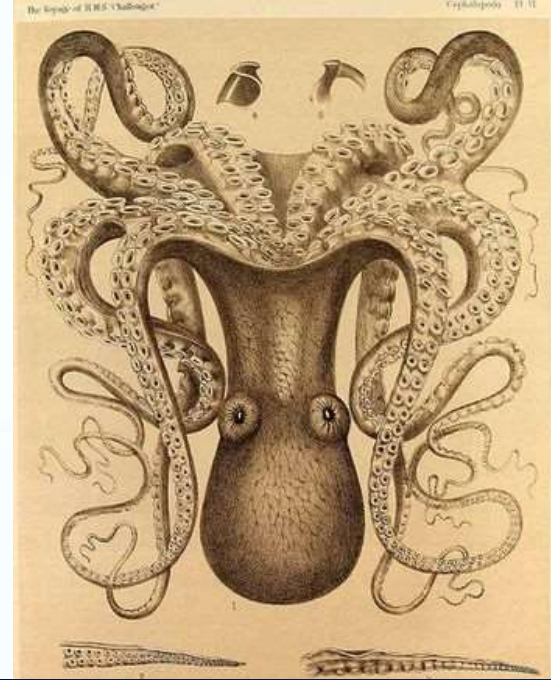

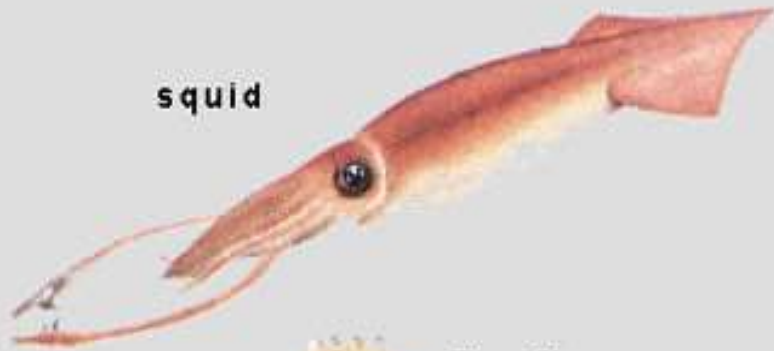

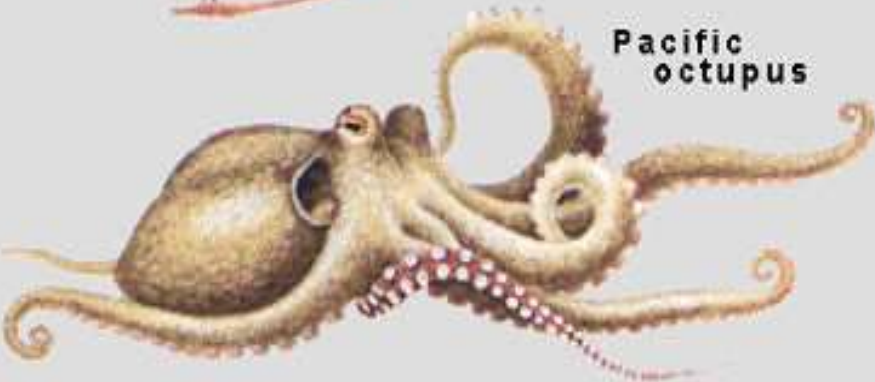

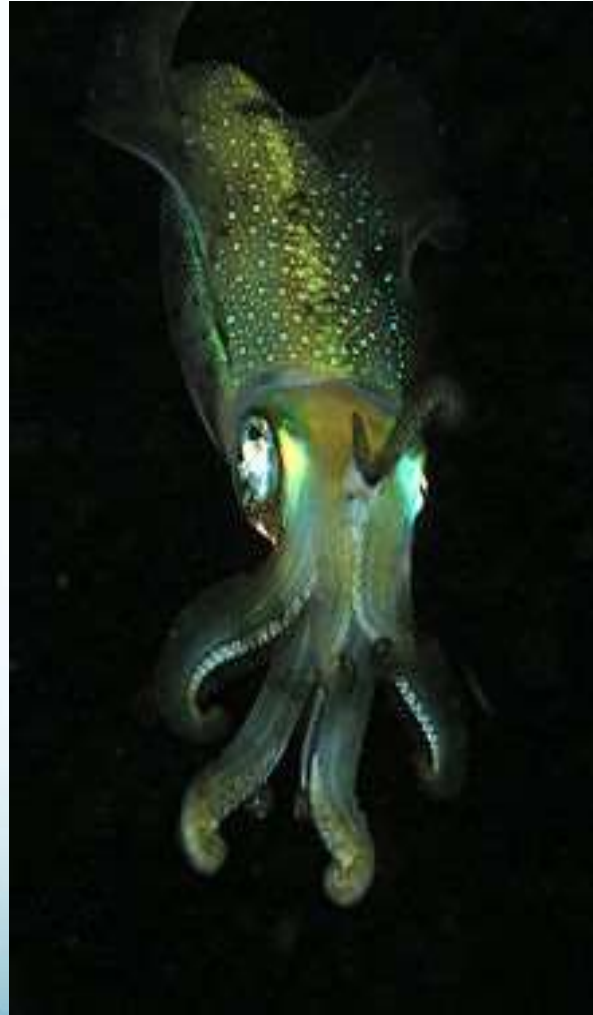

Feeding

-Most are predators using arms, tentacles, suckers to capture then **beak** to rip prey apart
