- **dis- (lt.); to separate + gerere (lt); move = divide (lt)**
- **Digerere; Digestus; Digesta**
- **Digest (ing); digest**
- **Digestion (ing); Digestion**

# Canalis Alimentarius

- **Alimenta (It); to separate small pieces**      **Alimentarius (It); Digestion**

# Cavum oris

- **Os (Lt.) = Oris (Gr.); Oral cavum; cavity**

**Proprium (Adv.); Proprius; individual, owner, master**

- **Vestibulum: open space in front of a house, entrance**
- **Ve - stabul**

**Ve; prefix meaning of outside**


**sto; stare- standing**

# Cavum oris

- **My Palate; roof of the mouth**
- **Dura; hard mollis; soft**
- **Rapha; stitch (line connecting two similar parts of a structure)**
- **For example; Raphe palati, raphe scroti**
  
- **Ruge; Crease, wrinkle, wrinkle**
- **Vela; fine grain texture eg; velum palatin, velum medullare (brain)**
  
- **Lingua (old latince de dingua); tongue (gr.); language glossitis \*\*\*; tongue**
- **Torus; convex bulge; torus linguae, tori (standing heel)**

# Cavum oris

- **Odon (gr.); tooth - dont (dens-lt.); tooth (protruding tooth), dentis, tooth**
- **For example; Homodont, periodontology, pulp dentis, axis dens**
- **\*Mola; millstone - molar; mill, grinder**
- **\* incisive (adj.); cutter, breaker, driller**

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- **Saliva; saliva**
  - **Parotid (gr.); money; ear + ous (like the last appendix)**
  - **Pharynx (Gr.) [Pharynges (pl), pharyngeal (Adj.)]; Throat, narrow passage, passage**

# Esophagus

- **Esophagus; Oesophagus [Esophagii (pl.), Esophageal (Adj.)]**
- **[Oisophagos (Gr.)]; Canal carrying the food**
- **phero (transport) + ephagon (food); (Future time form); Oisemen**

# Gaster

- **Gaster (Gr.); Cavity**
- **Ventriculus (It.); Small space**
- **Cardia; Kardia (Gr.); Heart**
- **Fundus (It.); bottom**
- **Corpus (It) [corpora (pl.)]; body**
- **Pylorus (Gr.) [Pylori (pl.)]; pyle (door) + ouros (guard)**



# Intestinum

- **Intus (Lt.); in / intestinus; internal, internal / intestinum [intestinal (Adj.)]; bowel**
- **Tanu (Gr.); Tenuis (It) [tenue (nominative withdrawal)]; thin**
- **Crassus (L.) [Crassa (fem.), Crassum (neutral)]; Thick, dense, solid**
- **Parvus (It.) [Parva (fem.), Parvum (neutral)]; small, insignificant**

# Anus

- **Ano (Gr.); ring / Anus (Gr.) [ani (pl.)]; Ring**
- **Anular (Adv); Annular**

# Hepar

- **Hepar (Gr.) [Hepatis (genitive attractiveness)]; Liver / Hepato-; It belongs to the liver.**
- **hepatocytes; Liver functional unit / Hepatitis; Liver inflammation**
- **lecur (It.) Liver / icter-; ... prefix in the sense of hug / icterus; jaundice**
- **Chole (Gr.); Biliary ductus choledochus**
- **Bilis (It.); Bile ductus biliferi**
- **Kysts (Gr.); Pouch, bag cyst, ductus cysticus**
- **Fellum; Fella**

# Pancreas

- **Pancreas (Gr.); pan (whole, whole) + creme (meat, raw meat)**
- **Ductus pancreaticus**
- **Pancreatitis (inflammation of the pancreas)**
