EPIDIDYMIS

a highly convoluted duct behind the testis, along which sperm passes to the vas deferens.

ACCESSORY GENITAL GLANDS

Glandulae genitales accessoriae

Vesicular gland (gl. vesicularis)

Prostate gland (gl. prostata)

Bulbourethral gland (gl. bulbourethralis)

UTERUS

Uterus / hystera / metra : uterus.

Endometrium: Uterus mucosa. Surrounding uterine cavity layer.

Myometrium: The endometrium of the uterus (uterus) layer between. The muscle layer of the uterus.

Perimetrium: The layer covering the uterus. Uterus serosus.

Cervix uteri (cervix uteri): Cervix. Under the body of the uterus, the vagina narrowed lower part, uterine neck.

Portio prevaginalis: The tip of the cervix uterine into the vagina partial.

Vagina / colpos: progeny, reservoir, female mating organ.
